15. Prisoners taken: No Prisoners of War were taken during period covered, however, Eighty-eight prisoners were treated and evacuated to higher echelon Medical Installations.

16. Summary: On the 2nd of Dec, a Surgical Team of the 60th FH with Major Partipilo in charge, was attached to this outfit. This team came from the 4th Aux Surg Gp.

On 7 Dec 44 a Pros Mobile Dental Lab #153 was attached to the Ctr Sta, commanded by Major Shinn.

On 15 Dec 44 the 3rd Plat of the 60th FH was rel'd and the 2nd Plat of the 16th FH was attached. Major A J Tulsy in command.

On 18 Dec 44, 15 ambulances were attached from the 593rd Amb Co. Lt Corona was Plat Leader. Plat was rel'd on 24 Dec 44. The same day the 1st and 3rd Plat of the 587th Amb Co were attached to the organization. Lt Frazer and Lt Kothbard were Plat Leaders.
