

15. Prisoners taken: No Prisoners of War were taken during period covered, however, one hundred and eight prisoners were treated and evacuated to higher echelon Medical Installations.

16. Summary: On 10 November 1944 the 2nd Platoon of the 587 Ambulance Company joined the Battalion. Platoon CO Lt. Pelosie.

On 16 November 1944, Lt. Waltz and a platoon of the 589 Ambulance Company were relieved, and the 1st Platoon of the 587 Amb. Co. with Platoon CO Lt. Rothbard joined the Battalion.

On 17 November Cpl Cerf was attached to the Battalion from the MI Corps for the purpose of interrogating PW's. Cpl Cerf was relieved by S/Sgt. Walker on 26 Nov.
