16. Summary: On 2 Oct 1944, the Sta Platoon of the 450th Med Coll Co (attached to 57th Med Bn for Adm) and Capt Porter, MC, Platoon CO, joined the 3rd Platoon of the 60th FH. This platoon is organized to act as a holding. This platoon was later relieved from the 60th FH on 19 Oct 1944.

On 7 Oct 1944, the 3rd Platoon of 450 Amb Co and Lt Moon, MAC, Platoon CO joined the Bn and relieved the 1st Platoon of the 450 Amb Co.
