**INTRODUCTORY:** This report covers the factual accounts of the operations of this headquarters in combat from August 1, 1944 to August 31, 1944 and is based on a day by day account of the operations of the S-1, S-2, S-3, S-4, Anti-Tank Section, and Air Liaison Sections. Operations of attached, organic and separate battalions will be covered in reports from their respective headquarters.

0001 1 Aug 44

Division Artillery continued to support the attack of the 35th Division moving to the South through Torigni-Sur-Vire toward Vire, with the 161st FA Bn in direct support of the 134th Inf, 216th FA Bn direct support of 320th Inf, 219th FA Bn direct support of the 137th Inf. The 127th FA Bn was in general support reinforcing the fires of the 216th FA Bn with the 186th FA (Medium Arty) in general support reinforcing fires of the 219th FA Bn. At 011600 Aug 1944, the 127th FA Bn and 186th FA were ordered to reinforce the fires of the 216th FA Bn. All organic and attached FA Bns moved to the vicinity SW of Torigni-Sur-Vire to support the attack through the night to secure the Vire River. 151 missions were fired by Division Artillery during the period including 23 counterbattery

missions, 9 of which were observed. A total of 4391 rounds were fired by organic artillery.

2 Aug 44

With the Vire River secured the division continued the attack to the South toward Vire. This unit moved to the SW of Torigni-Sur-Vire and the organic artillery with the exception of 219th FA Bn and the 186th FA crossed the Vire River moving to positions to the South to support the attack. The 216th FA Bn direct support of 320th Inf, 161st FA Bn direct support 134th Inf, 219th FA Bn direct support of 137th Inf. 127th FA Bn in general support reinforce fires of 216th FA Bn, 186th FA in general support reinforcing fires of 219th FA Bn. Both medium battalions prepared to answer call missions of the 161st FA Bn. 277 missions were fired during the period with 7 counterbattery missions, one unobserved. A total of 4363 rounds were fired by organic artillery. The 448th AAA was given the mission of protecting the river crossings.

3 Aug 44

Scattered resistance by the enemy continued to the NW of Vire delaying our infantry. The 35th Div Arty reinforced, supported the attack of the division beginning at 0800, to the South. 2nd Inf Div on the left or East and 29th Division pinched out the 30th Division on the right or West. No changes were made in missions of the artillery attachments. All battalions were prepared to mass fires on either flank of the Division Front. 458 missions were fired, 7 counterbattery, with a total of 3084 rounds expended. The 654th TD Bn, further attached by companies to the infantry regiments moved in close support with all TD units having crossed the river by 1800. Two platoons of TD's were left to guard the river crossings. This unit displaced forward to vicinity of St Marie south of the Vire River.

4 Aug 44

The 35th Infantry moved on forward to the NW of Vire along the road running

NW out of Vire and prepared to hold objective. 29th Division on the right moving West to East to pinch out the 35th Division and meet 2nd Division to continue the attack on Vire. 186th FA Bn reverted to Corps Control. No change in location of troops with exception of 127th FA Bn which displaced to the South of St Marie. No change in the organization for combat. 284 missions were fired with an ammunition expenditure of 218 rounds. With the high ground NW of Vire captured the AT guns were placed well forward in event of a reported mechanized move by the enemy toward Vire from the West. At 1500 the division was ordered into Corps reserve after being pinched off by the 29th Division.

5 August 44

The 35th Division alerted for and moved to the vicinity of Villedieu in a concentration area. This unit moved starting at approximately 2000, a distance of 13 miles and moved into Rendezvous vicinity NE Avranches. 35th Division passed to control of 15th Corps but changed to 20th Corps, Third Army. The 216th FA Bn and 161st FA Bn closed in new area prior to midnight, with other elements of Div Arty enroute. 127th FA Bn and 654th TD remained in old area near St Marie and moved 6 Aug 1944. No missions were fired during the period. No rounds were fired.

6 Aug 44

35th Division alerted for move to the South in the vicinity of Lovigne-Du-Desert and sent out reconnaissance early in the morning. This unit moved at 1800 20 miles to vicinity North of Lovigne-Du-Desert. All artillery closed in that vicinity by 0500 Aug 7, 1944. No operations for the period and no missions fired.

7 Aug 44

Division alerted by enemy threat from the NE vicinity of Mortain and Barenton. All organic battalions were ordered to place their guns in position in defense direction of fire to the East. 161st FA Bn in direct support of 134th Inf, The 219th FA Bn in direct support of 137th Inf, and 216th FA Bn direct support of 320th Inf. The 137th Inf and 134th Inf were alerted and

moved to the East of the division concentration area to cover the flank. 320th Inf in reserve in present concentration area. Air Liaison Section maintained constant air surveillance of Mortain-Barenton area to the East. Two companies of TD's attached to combat teams, one company in reserve to reinforce the fires of the 127th FA Bn, supporting fires of the 216th FA Bn. All battalions of the CT's were alerted for 30 min. notice of a move to counteract the threat. CT 137th and CT 134th moved by motors to secure the phase line from Mortain to Barenton. No rounds fired.

8 Aug 44

No change in attachments of artillery. Division met strong organized resistance North of Notre Dame de Touchet. 161st FA Bn fired one mission in adjustment on tanks. Division Artillery moved into vicinity NW of Notre Dame de Touchet to support the attack. 35th Division was reverted to VII Corps control and took up the offensive. 270 rounds fired.

9 Aug 44

This unit displaced 10 miles to the vicinity of Notre Dame de Touchet and closed into the new area at 1300. 127th FA Bn displaced forward to support fires of the CT's. CT's ceased at 1700 and artillery was reverted to Division control. Defensive fires were immediately set up for the night. Div Arty massed fires on enemy strong points and tanks during the afternoon and evening with a total of 10 Div Arty massed fires. 61 missions were fired with an expenditure of 2698 rounds.

10 Aug 44

Div Arty continued to support the attack of the division at 1500 with 42 battalion concentrations covering the advance and with smoke screens on enemy OP's in the Foret de Mortain. Preparation fires began at 1450, with the artillery attachments remaining the same. Defensive fire plans for the night 10 Aug 44 included concentrations on stream beds and mountain passes in the Foret de Mortain area. A total of 205 missions were fired; 51 enemy strong

points, 11 enemy batteries, 2 tanks, 3 enemy OP's, 133 interdiction and harrassing, 3 smoke and 2 air strikes. A total of 3940 rounds were fired.

11 Aug 44

Div Arty continued to support the attack of the division with the 30th Division on the left approaching Mortain, and with the 4th Division taking over the sector of the 137th Inf. 183rd FA Bn attached to the 35th Div Arty by VII Corps Arty. Div Arty fired defensive fires between 110001 B and 110600 B and direct support during the day. 320th Inf with 216th FA Bn was to gain contact with 30th Division units stranded East of Mortain. 161st FA Bn to reinforce the fires of the 216th FA Bn. 127th FA Bn in general support reinforcing fires of 216th FA Bn, with 183rd in general support reinforcing fires of 219th FA Bn in support of the 137th Inf. Div Arty fired 224 missions with 170 harrassing and interdiction, 23 on enemy strong points, 28 close in support and 3 on enemy batteries. Rounds expended, 2639.

12 Aug 44

Div Arty continued the support of the attack of the Division. Objective of Mortain-Barenton Road was reached by all units and 137th Inf and 320th Inf were ordered to continue to attack to the East. No change in the artillery attachments. Div Arty fired interdiction, harrassing and close in support missions. The 183rd FA was relieved from attachment to Div Arty at 2100. 137 missions were fired consisting of 15 interdiction, 72 harrassing, 5 enemy batteries, 9 strong points and 42 close in fires with total rounds expended, 1810.

13 Aug 44

35th Div was relieved from attachment VII Corps and attached to XII Corps. All elements of the Div Arty and attached units were relieved from the tactical situation. 3 light battalions CT'd with respective regiments enroute to vicinity of LeMans at close of period. 38 rounds were fired before units were relieved.

14 Aug 44

At 0230 this unit moved 65 miles to the vicinity SE of LeMans by route through Landivy, Ernee, Loue and LeMans. All artillery was CT'd for the move and arrived in position in the vicinity SE of LeMans in division concentration area. All units closed by 142100 Aug 1944. No rounds fired.

15 Aug 44

Orders received ordered division to advance and take the town of Orleans. Task Force "S" with 137th Inf, 219th FA Bn with 127th FA Bn attached, 1 company TD, 1 platoon Engineers and other attached troops moved out for Orleans at 1200. This unit as part of a Serial moved at 1600 via St Calais, Moree, Boussy to vicinity of Boussy arriving at 2400. 255th FA (-1 btry on detached duty) 105mm How and 974th FA (medium M-1) were attached to the 35th Div Arty and moved as part of a serial. Other organic artillery CT'd for the move to Orleans. No rounds fired.

16 Aug 44

Division was given mission of securing Chateaudun, with 320th Inf CT with 216th FA Bn moving out at 1200 to vicinity of La Ferte Illeneuil area. Task Force "S" proceeded to take Orleans. This unit moved to the vicinity north of La Ferte Illemuil arriving at 1500. 320th Inf CT held up on outskirts of Chateaudun by organized enemy resistance. 255th FA (-) and 974th FA reinforced the fires of the 216th FA Bn being in position near La Ferte Illeneuil. A total of 55 missions were fired by CT 320th and attached artillery. TD's not committed, during this period performed maintenance in reserve. Total number of rounds for period, 1268.

17 Aug 44

320th CT advanced and took Chateaudun and the high ground to the North. One platoon of TD ordered to vicinity of Cloyes for protection of vital river crossings on Le-Loire River. Div given mission of holding Chateaudun. Div Arty further reinforced by 802 FA (105 How) and the 191st FA (155 How) with 182nd Group moving in with 179th and 945th FA Bns (155 How) to reinforce the

fires of Div Arty. Task Force "S" was further reinforced by 558th and 731st FA Bns (155 Gun) from XII Corps. Task Force "S" secured the town of Orleans, but still met resistance from mortars and artillery from South of the town across the river. Rounds fired, 1387.

18 Aug 44

Division continued to hold Chateaudun with 320th CT, 216th FA Bn reinforced by 802nd and 974th FA. 161st FA Bn arrived in vicinity of La Ferte and reinforced fires of 216th FA Bn. Orleans held by Task Force "S". Rounds fired, 89.

19 Aug 44.

Division prepared to move out to vicinity of Sougy near Artenay with CT 320th with 216th and CT 134th with 161st moving out on parallel roads to the East. For the move to vicinity of Artenay 255th FA attached to 216th FA Bn, 974th attached to 161st FA Bn and the 802nd FA and 191st, moved under 182nd FA Group control. This unit moved 42 miles arriving in new CP vicinity of Sougy at 2000. Artillery with Task Force "S" fired several interdiction and harrassing missions South of the River at Orleans. 1021 Rounds fired.

20 Aug 44

New Division mission given to secure Pithiviers to the East. 219th and 127th FA Bns moved to vicinity of Artenay. The 219th FA Bn CT'd with 137th Inf (less one battalion in Orleans) with "D" Btry of 448th AAA attached to the 4th Armored Division with mission of securing Sens. The 320th CT with 216th FA Bn with 127th FA Bn attached with Co C 654th TD to secure Pithiviers, attacking at 0700 21 Aug. 255th FA attached to 216th FA Bn, 191st FA reinforce fires of 216th, 161st, with 974th FA attached and Co A TD Bn moves by marching to capture high ground in vicinity of Izy. 802nd FA Bn to reinforce fires of 161st FA Bn. No rounds fired.

21 Aug 44

Division with artillery support advanced on Pithiviers. This unit moved 20 miles at 1700 arriving vicinity West of Pithiviers. No opposition was

encountered and infantry secured the town and high ground to the East.  
Artillery in position East of town. No rounds fired.

22 Aug 44

Division given mission of securing Montargis. Artillery plan to support the advance of the Division was as follows: 320th CT with 216th FA Bn with 127th FA Bn attached, 802nd reinforcing fires of 216th FA Bn. 161st with 255th FA attached CT, 134th Inf, with 945th reinforcing fires of 161st FA Bn. This unit moved 25 miles to vicinity SE Ladon. Infantry advanced to outskirts of Montargis. Artillery in position general vicinity East of Ladon. Five fire missions were fired during the period. No artillery fire was placed on the town of Montargis. 168 rounds fired.

23 Aug 44

Division continued to attack Montargis. Scattered enemy resistance unorganized. An artillery plan was organized to attempt to get the occupants to surrender. A representative from G-2 visited the town to get a surrender. Occupants were to be told they would be destroyed at 1300 if they didn't surrender. Artillery fire was planned to be fired to the North and South of the town at 1300 if occupants didn't surrender. At 1300 fire was placed to the North and South of the town three battalions massed in each place but fire was ceased when the G-2 returned stating there were no troops in the city. The infantry advanced and took complete control of the city. Meanwhile careful planning for any use of artillery had to be worked out with 4th Armored Division coming in from the East on Montargis. Germans were reported to have withdrawn in the forest to the East of Montargis. The 738th FA (8 in How) was attached to the 182nd FA Group, further reinforcing the fires of the 35th Division Artillery. 9 massed fire missions were fired, direct support bns firing several observed missions on targets of opportunity. 732 rounds fired.

24 Aug 44

No change in Division mission. Infantry continued to mop up remaining German resistance in the Forests East of Montargis. 1 round fired.

25 Aug 44

The 161st FA Bn with 127th FA Bn attached, 1 platoon of 654th and CT 134th started marching on Joigny, completely motorized, at 0700 and arrived with no opposition. 216th FA Bn CT with 320th Inf to Courtenay area with no opposition. 255th FA attached to 182nd FA Group for the march to Courtenay. 219th FA Bn CT with 134th to rejoin Division in Courtenay area 25 Aug. No rounds fired.

26 Aug 44

Division given the mission of securing the right flank of the Army from Troyes to Orleans. The 255th FA moved to a central location between Orleans and Gien N of the Loire to support the 3rd Bn 137th Inf against any threat from the South. 219th FA Bn moved to vicinity of Chateaurenard to support the 2nd Bn 137th Inf between Gien and Romanie against any threat from the South. The 161st FA Bn with 127th FA Bn attached remained in position near Joigny to support 134th against any threat from the South and East between Romaine and Troyes. 216th FA Bn alerted to move with 1st Bn 320th Inf to vicinity of Troyes was ordered. 802nd, 945th, 752nd under 182nd Group control in present positions. No rounds fired.

27 Aug 44

The 738th FA was detached 0700 from 182nd Group. 216th FA Bn moved to vicinity of Troyes with 1st Bn 320th Inf. Other units no change. Division in the defense of the right flank of army. No rounds fired.

28 Aug 44

Threat of recapture of Troyes by enemy was present. Task force "S" was formed consisting of remaining CT 320th and 2 companies of 654th TD Bn, with reinforcing artillery of 182nd Group, all alerted at 1500 to move to vicinity of Troyes to defend the town. No change in missions of 255th FA and 219th FA Bns. This unit remained in vicinity of Courtenay. 144 rounds fired.

29 Aug 44

The 161st FA Bn and 127th FA Bn moved into bivouac in vicinity of Aix-en-Othe

with CT 134th, relieved in sector of defense by the 106th Cavalry. CT 134th reverted to Division reserve in view of threat on Troyes. This unit moved 60 miles via Sens to area near Fontvannes. Infantry vicinity of Troyes dug in on East of city. Initially 182nd Group moved in position West of city, later moving to East of city. Task Force "S" prepared to attack reported enemy positions. 66 rounds fired.

20 Aug 44.

Task Force "S" with 320th and 216th FA Bn attack along with the 4th Armored Division on the left to the South east to objective Between Bar-sur-Seine and Vendeuvre-sur-Barse and received only scattered resistance. Co B, 654th TD alerted for move immediately to vicinity of Troyes to revert to Bn control. A total of 31154 rounds were fired up to this time during the month.

31 Aug 44

Task Force "S" (-) moved at 1800 to vicinity of Brienne-le-Chateau with the mission of attacking or counterattacking to the East, South east, and North east, and continue to protect the SE flank of the Division. 3rd Bn 320th Inf remained with Co C 654th TD Bn and with 802nd FA in direct support in present area. Mission to protect S flank of the Task Force. 216th FA Bn and 182nd Gp (-) moved to general vicinity of Brienne le Chateau. 161st FA Bn and 127th FA Bn remained in reserve. 219th FA Bn and 255th FA Bn remained protecting Gien, Orleans sector with 127th Inf. Total rounds expended for month of August: 31154.

GENERAL:

Headquarters Battery to date in operations in France had laid 200 miles of wire and maintained excellent communications with organic and attached units. Morale and efficiency in the headquarters is excellent and the fighting efficiency and stamina of men and officers is unlimited.

AIR LIAISON SECTION

During the month of August 1944 Division Artillery Air Officer had centralized control of planes with the exception of the latter part of the month with the Division protecting the flank of Army. During this period alternate airfields were set up vicinity of each Combat Team or Task Force operating separately. Division Artillery Air Section maintained constant surveillance during the month and aided artillery in the location of front line troops, enemy and friendly; the air adjustments of observers were also highly effective and at times the only observation and direction of artillery fire available. One plane lost in combat by enemy ground fire 9 Aug 44 vicinity Mortain. Lt R. K. Price, pilot, and Lt Peter J. Nolan, observer, received injuries. Two planes were damaged by windstorm on the ground, and one plane damaged by hitting obstruction in field. Total aircraft replacement: four.
