SUBJECT: Report After Action Against Enemy.

1. In compliance with the previsions of Par 10 C3, AR 345-105, submitted below is report after action against the enemy for the 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized covering the period 1-28 February 1945.

### February 1, 1945

The 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized remained in assembly area at Terlinden, Holland after completing motor move from Haudainville, France on January 31, 1945.

### February 2, 3, 1945

The 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized remained in assembly area at Terlinden, Holland.

### February 4, 1945

The 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized moved by motor from Terlinden, Holland to Randerath, Germany, relieving B Squadron, 52nd British Recce Regiment. Troop CP and 1st Platoon were in Randerath and the 2nd and 3rd Platoons were in Horst, Germany. The Troop left Terlinden, Holland at 0900 and the hand over was completed by 1300.

### February 5, 6, 7, 1945

The 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized continued to hold Randerath and Horst on right flank of the 35th Infantry Division. Contact was maintained with 1st Bn, 320th Infantry on Troop left and 1st Bn, 106th Infantry, on the Troop right.

### February 8, 1945

CEN The 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized was relieved by elements of Inthi Infantry at 1830 and moved to assembly area at Gangelt, Germany by 2000.

February 9-21, 1915

February 9-24, 1945
The 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized remained in Division Reserve at angett, Germany.

## February 25, 1945

The 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized prepared to execute a smoke in connection with the bridging of the Roer River. The 1st Platoon moved to Brachelen, 2nd platoon to Himmerich and the 3rd Platoon to Porselen. The Troop CP remained in Gangelt.

February 26, 1945

The 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized remained in position to execute shoke mission. -1-

# February 27, 1945

The 35th Recommaissance Troop, Mechanized moved to assembly area at Porselen, Germany.

# February 28, 1945

The 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized performed reconnaissance in 13hth Infantry sector on Division left flank. Mine fields delayed progress of 1st and 2nd Platoons. 1st Platoon contacted enemy in vicinity of Herkenbosch, Holland. Troop CP and trains at Birgelen with 3rd Platoon in reserve.

There were no Battle Casualties for the month of February 1945.
