SUBJECT: Report After Action Against Enemy.

TO : The Adjutant General, Washington, D. C.  
(Thru Channels)

1. In compliance with the provisions of Par 10 C3, AR 345-105, submitted below is report after action against the enemy for the 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized covering the period of 1-31 May 1945.

1 May 1945 to 17 May 1945

The 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized remained assembled south of Hannover, at Wulfe, Germany. Division Headquarters employed one platoon twenty-four hours daily on a special security mission, this detail being rotated between the first, second and third platoons during the period. The remainder of the troop was held in division reserve. A Special detail of six armored cars was provided to maintain order as German Civilians disinterred the bodies of several hundred Russian laborers from a common grave and gave them formal burial in Hannover. The detail coordinated with Military Government and Military Police authorities who were in charge.

18 May 1945

The 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized prepared to move to new area in vicinity of Recklinghausen, Germany. Advance detail moved 17 May 1945.

19 May 1945

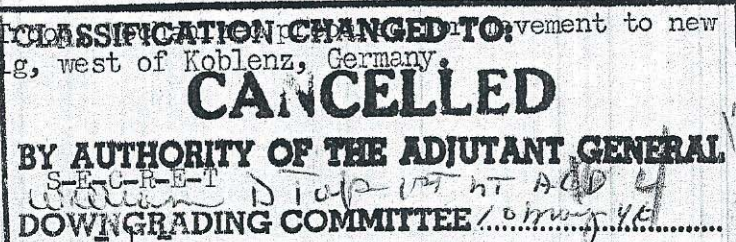
The 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized moved by motor from Wulfe, Germany to Recklinghausen Germany, a distance of 160 miles. Departed at 0700 hours and arrived in new area at 1440 hours.

20 May 1945 to 30 May 1945

The 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized remained in division reserve. The period was devoted largely to care and cleaning of equipment. Equipment of all branches of supply was inventoried and inspected. Extensive motor maintenance was carried on, including the painting of vehicles. Captured vehicles were turned into ordnance collecting points. Two special guard details were provided for Division Athletic Facilities, consisting of seven and five men respectively. Troop was alerted for movement to new area and advanced detail departed 30 May 1945.

31 May 1945

The 35th Reconnaissance Troop, Mechanized moved to new area in vicinity of Nord-Mendig, west of Koblenz, Germany.

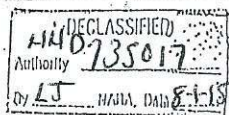
