 TO : Historical section G-2, 35th Inf. Div.

1. The function of the 735th Ord. Co. (LM) for the period 1 Aug 44 to 31 Aug 1944 is as follows:

Aug 1 to Aug 8, inclusive.  
 Supply Section.

Items recovered and sent to higher echelon, 249 M-1 Rifles, four M1903A1 Rifles, three launchers rocket AT 2.36, bayonets w/scabbard nineteen, BAR's five and nine Carbines M-1.

Items recovered for stock, one launcher grenade, four projector pyro hand, three bayonets M-1 twenty seven carbines and one BAR.

Ord. major items issued, twelve carbines, four launchers grenade one 60MM Mortar, four projector pyrotechnic, fifty six rifles M-1 three BAR's, one M-3 sub machinegun, five Launcher rocket 2.36 one pistol Cal. 45 and on 1/4 ton trailer.

Automotive section: Jobs received, eleven. Welding jobs nine, batteries repaired and serviced fourteen, three radiators repaired. Five vehicles evacuated. Total work orders completed thirty two. Automotive inspection team inspected 36 vehicles in eight units.

Small arms repair: seventy five carbines Cal..30 M-1, twenty six BMG Cal.30, four mounts tripod cal.30, twenty two BAR's, fifty eight Rifles cal.30 M1, three pistols cal. 45, eight Launchers rocket AT 2.36 one submachine gun Cal..45 M-3, five BMG Cal..30 M1919A4 modified to A-6 three BMG Cal..50 HB M-2 repaired.

Artillery and instrument repair: one 155MM Howitzer M-1, one 105 MM Gun M-3, two 105 MM Howitzer M2A1, two 57 MM At guns, one 37 MM gun M-6, two Mounts mortar M-2, one sight M-4, one pair binoculars, six telescopic sights M-73 BL, and one Telescopic mount M-23.

9 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received two jobs, finished one. Deadline one. one evacuation. Contact team inspected two vehicles of Hq. Co. eleven vehicles of the 320th Inf.

Artillery section contacts: Jockey, ABC and Joplin Cn Co.

Small Arms contacts: Jockey, ABC, Joplin Victory, repaired one launcher two BAR's, one Cal..30 MG and five M-1 Rifles.

Battle loss equipment : 39 M-1 rifles, four Cal..30 MG, four carbines four BAR's.

10 Aug 1944

Automotive Shop: Completed tow jobs, one vehicle evacuated. Three wreckers evacuated five vehicles from the battlefield. One wrecker furnished to the Engineers to tow bulldozer.

Small arms contacts: Justice able one rifle M-1, Jumbo S-4 two Carbines, one Launcher rocket, Juniper S-4, three Launchers rocket, Joplin S-4, three BAR's, two cal..30 MG six carbines, nine M-1 rifles and four Launchers rocket. Battle loss equipment, 31 carbines, one BAR and eleven rifles M-1

Artillery contacts: Jumbo S-4 Able one 155 MM Howitzer repaired. Baker one 155 MM Howitzer repaired, Charlie no repair. Jockey S-4 ABC no repair. Joplin S-4 picked up one 60 MM Mortar. Evacuated one 105 MM Howitzer M-3 from battlefield that had been damaged by enemy fire. Contacted 47th Ord. Co. to pick up repaired watches.

11 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received three vehicles, finished six. Deadline two. No evacuations. Contact team: 35th Sig. Co. twelve vehicles inspected.

Artillery Section: Joplin Cn Co. repaired one 57 MM Gun M-1, One 57 MM M-1 evacuated to Helpfull MM Co. Received twenty watches from Helpfull. Joplin S-4 repaired one 81 MM Mortar exchanged one 81 MM Mortar.

Jumbo Baker: Repaired one M-19 Instrument.

Small arms contacts: Joplin S-4, repaired two Cal..30 ML903A4 rifles and one Cal..50 HB MG M-2. Justice repaired two carbines cal..30 M-1 and one rifle Cal..30 M-1. Battle loss equipment: One launcher Rocket AT 2.36 and one BAR Cal..30 ML918A2.

12 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received four vehicles, finished five, deadline none. One evacuation and replacement. Contact team Hq. Co. twelve vehicles inspected.

Small Arms contacts: Joplin, one pistol Cal..45, two rocket launchers and one BAR Cal..30 ML918A2. Jumbo service ABC no repair. No battle losses.

Artillery section: Jumbo ABC replaced air hose elbow. Joplin Cn.Co. No repair. Justice Easy repaired one sight on scout car M-8. June two pistols, Cal..45.

13 and 14 Aug 1944

Co. shops not in operation on these dates.

15 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received twenty two vehicles, finished twenty. Deadline two. Contact team, Div. Arty five vehicles inspected.

Artillery and instrument repair: Jumbo ABC. Picked up gun books to check total rounds fired. Jockey ABC, repaired one mount telescope and four range quadrants. Joplin repaired two mounts for 81 MM Mortar. One base plate 81 MM Mortar and two mount telescope M-16. Helpfull MM Co. contacted for repair of one 105 MM gun M-3 and two 81 MM Mortars.

Small arms contacts: Joplin repaired two Cal..30 MG 1919A4, one rifle Cal..30 ML903A4, one pistol Cal..45, three carbines, six BAR's and one Launcher rocket. Justice Charlie, repaired two carbines. Juniper repaired one BAR and one pistol Cal..45. Jumbo three carbines Judge one carbine.

16 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received four vehicles, evacuated four. Deadline two. No automotive contacts. Supply and armament sections not in operation.

17 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received three vehicles, finished three, deadline none. One evacuation. Contact team, Justice Dog, twelve vehicles inspected.

Small Arms contacts: Joplin repaired eight BAR'S rifles M1918A2. three BMG Cal..30 M1919A4, two launchers rocket AT 2.36. Juniper one BAR. Justice one carbine. Jumbo one pistol. Battle loss repairs four carbines one BMG Cal..50 HB M-2.

Artillery contacts: Jumbo ABC no repair. June ABC no repair. Joplin AT Co. Cn. Co. S-4 no repair. Helfull MM Co. contacted.

18 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received four vehicles finished two. Deadline two Contact team, 60th Engineers, twelve vehicles inspected.

Artillery contacts: Joplin S-4, repaired one firing mechanism for 57 MM AT gun M-1, one mount mortar 60 MM one 105 MM gun M-3. Jumbo ABC No repair. Jockey ABC no repair. June ABC, investigated muzzle burst of 105 Howitzer M2A1. Repaired two panoramic sights. Judge ABC. No repair. evacuated one 57 MM gun M-1 for repair and one mortar mount to Helfull MM Co.

Small arms contacts: Joplin, one BAR. Justice one carbine. Justice Easy, one pistol. 216th and 161st F.A., no repair. 127th one carbine one pistol. 219th no repair. Battle loss equipment, one carbine.

19 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received one vehicle, finished two. Deadline one. One evacuation. Contact team, 60th Eng. nine vehicles inspected/

Artillery and instrument contacts: Jockey A and B battery no repair. C Btry issued one purge plug. Repaired one aiming circle, one telescope observation M-49. Judge ABC Btry no repair. Joplin S-4, picked up one sight M-4 one mount 60 MM Mortar for repair. Jumbo A Btry issued one gas check pad. Easy, one scout car M-8 sent to Helfull for repair.

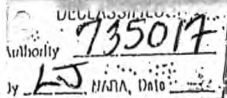
Small arms contacts: Jockey ABC no repair. Judge A. Btry no repair B Btry one pistol Cal..45. C. Btry no repair. Joplin S-4 no repair Unit repair Juniper, one Cal..50 MG, one pistol. Ord. items issued, twelve launcher rockets, eight mounts 30..Cal. MG. two mounts mortar, one mount M24A1, fifty bayonets M-1 50 scabbards M-7, 34 knife trench. Twenty three pistols one carbine. Turned in, eighteen M-1 rifles and four carbines. Enemy material, one car personnel carrier and one MG.

20 Aug 1944

Automotive section not in operation.

Small arms contacts: Joplin, two launchers rockets, one BAR.

Artillery Section: One telescopic sight M-18 one 57 MM gun M-1

21 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Recieved four jobs, rinished one. Deadline one. two evacuations. Contact team, 110th Medics, Hq. rive vehicles, Co. D, seven vehicles

Small arms contacts: Juniper S-4, one pistol, one BAR and one M-1 rifle. 35th Recon one Cal..50MG. 35th QM Co. one carbine.

Artillery section: Justice, repaired one 57MM AT gun M-1. 974th F.A. Bn one aiming circle M-1.

22 Aug 1944

Co. shops not in operation this date. Unit was moving to a new location.

23 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received nine vehicles, finished five. Deadline four. Received one GMC as replacement. Contact team, 134th Inf. HS Co. eleven vehicles inspected.

Small arms contacts: Joplin one pistol Cal..45. Juniper, three carbines repaired, eleven M-1 rifles inspected. Jumbo B Btry. two carbines, C Btry one carbine repaired.

Artillery and instrument repair contacts: Jumbo A Btry inspected one 155 MM Howitizer, B Btry no repair, C Btry no repair. Juniper S-4 Received watches for repair. Repaired one sight telescopic M-73 B-1.

24 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received two vehicles, finished five. Deadline one. Evacuation section spent the day at a German motor pool salvaging enemy vehicles for use by the division.

Small arms contacts: Joplin S-4, one Cal..50 MG HB M-2

Artillery contacts: Jumbo A Btry repaired one 155 MM Howitizer issued one firing lockand one obturator spindle plug. Joplin S-4 one Cal..50 MG. Helpfull MM Co. picked up one pistol Cal..45 twelve pins firing for 155 MM Howitizer and one launcher rocket AT 2.36.

25 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received two vehicles, finished none. Deadline one. Evacuations three. Three German vehicles in shop for repair.

Artillery contacts: Jumbo, ABC Btry no repair. Helpfull MM Co. Turned in watches for repair.

26 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received three vehicles, finished one. Deadline three. No evacuations. Contacts, 161st F.A. B Btry, ten vehicles inspected.

Artillery contacts: Jumbo S-4, AB Btrys no repair, C Btry, one carbine repaired. Jockey AB Btry no repair. C Btry repaired one carbine.

June S-4, A Btry inspected gun tube tightened worm gear on gun. B Btry inspected gun tube repaired range quadrant. C Btry no repair. Helpfull MM Co. turned in 14 wrist watches. Picked up 105 MM Parts and one aiming light for Judge.

26 Aug 1944

Small arms contact: June S-4, one rocket launcher, one carbine repaired, one carbine exchanged. Juniper S-4 two carbines replaced one repaired. One pistol repaired, six carbines inspected. Jumbo A Btry one M-1 repaired. Juniper one launcher rocket repaired.

27 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: No jobs received. two jobs finished. Deadline none. One evacuation. Contact team: 161st F.A. C Btry 12 vehicles inspected.

Small arms contacts: Justice repaired one M-3 MG. Juniper S-4, inspected one 30 Cal. MG 1919A4. Justice Easy, repaired one MG, cal..30 1919A4.

Artillery contacts: June C Btry, replaced plunger and knob on draw bar of 105 MM M2A1. Judge B Btry replaced elevating gear on four 105 M2A1 C Btry repacked elevating gear cases on four 105 M2A1. Jockey ABC no repair.

28 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received four vehicles, finished none. Deadline two. Evacuations two. One replacement received. Contact team 161st F.A. A Btry 12 vehicles inspected.

Small arms contacts: June S-4, A Btry no repair. B Btry repaired one Carbine. C Btry no repair. Battle loss weapons Jury repaired three Carbines and three M-1 rifles. Unit repairs: Jury two rocket launchers One Cal..30 MG. Jordan one M-3 MG.

Artillery contacts: ~~June~~ June A Btry replace elevating gear case on four weapons. B Btry repack elevating gear on four weapons. Replaced two shield jackets, replaced one knob and plunger on lunette latch. C Btry repacked elevating gear cases on four weapons replaced one shield bracket.

29 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received two vehicles, finished two. Deadline one. One evacuation.

Artillery contacts: Jumbo ABC Btry, eight gas check pad issued. Helpfull MM Co. picked up two 1903A4 rifles and one 30 Cal..MG. Requested nine plugs oburator spindle for 155 MM howitzers.

30 Aug 1944

Automotive shop: Received eight vehicles, finished three. Deadline five. One evacuation. One repaired vehicle returned.

Small arms contacts: Judge A Btry no repair.

Artillery contacts: Judge A Btry repacked elevating gear cases on four 105 MM Howitzers. June B Btry exchanged one 105 Howitzer with unserviceable tube. Helpfull MM Co. delivered watches for repair.

31 Aug 1944

Automotive Shop: Received three vehicles, finished five. Deadline three. No evacuations, no contacts.

Artillery contacts: None. Repair, one sight M-4

Small Arms contacts: None. Unit repair, one launcher rocket AT. 2.36 two cal..30 1919A4. three pistols automatic cal..45.
