1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- Enemy nearest elements - See overlay.
- Defensive organization - The enemy does not have an organized defensive position in our sector.
- Units in contact - In the 134th sector contact with 2d Bn 73d Inf Regt (19th Div). In the 137th sector in contact with elements of the three regts of the 559th Div. Scattered elements were also reported in both sectors.
- Artillery - See overlay.
- Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - 59th and 74th Inf Regts of the 19th Div are as yet unidentified in our sector. PWs report however that these regts may be moving from the N as reinforcements.
- Supply and administrative elements - See overlay.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- General summary - The enemy's attitude during the entire period was defensive; and our advance to the E and N forced the enemy to withdraw.
- Operations of component elements:
 - Artillery - Artillery was very heavy and accurate early in the period yesterday evening but last night and during the day today it is believed the artillery has pulled back and very little firing was reported.
 - Infantry - Withdrew under pressure to the E and NE.
 - Tanks - 2 to 4 dug-in tanks reported at 982284. Very little armor activity reported.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- Estimated enemy casualties 250. Enemy dead buried 2.
- Prisoners - 31 PWs captured during period. Grand total 7,011.
- Weather - Overcast tonight with scattered showers, breaking by tomorrow.
- Password - THACKERY reply ENGLISH from 021200 October to 031200 October 1944
- Miscellaneous - Units are again reminded about the prohibition against civilians passing thru the lines.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: No change.
