1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - The enemy does not have an organized front line in the sector of this Div.
- b. Defensive organization - Confirmation reports show that the enemy continues to defend along his routes of withdrawal including the towns of CHATILON H6820, CHAUMONT Z0649 and NEUFCHATEAU Z4975. Scattered enemy defensive positions are also reported from CHAUMONT N to JOINVILLE Z0886.
- c. Units in contact - Elements of the 15th Div are now reported moving to the E S. of ORLEANS.
- d. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - The troops S of ORLEANS may be reinforced by the remaining elements of the 15th Div moving to the E.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - Enemy continues to withdraw to the E and NE defending his routes of withdrawal along the towns indicated.
- b. Operations of component elements:
  - 1. Aviation - One enemy ron plane flew over the area vic ORLEANS at 1215.
  - 2. Infantry - No change in the estimate of troops on our S flank.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. No enemy casualties reported during period. Enemy dead buried none.
- b. Prisoners - 38 P's captured during period. Grand total 4,464.
- c. Weather - Cloudy with little change in temperature.
- d. Password - RADIO reply TELEPHONE from 021200 September to 031200 September 1944.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES - No change.
