1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - No change.
- b. Defensive organization - No change. See mine rap overlay attached.
- c. Units in contact - CT Mueller and CT Eggersh, formed from personnel of the 11th Pz Div, were identified in our sector.
- d. Artillery - No change.
- e. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - No change.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - Enemy continued defensive action in our sector and sporadically harassed the forward units with light artillery.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 1. Artillery - 9 rounds of heavy arty (280) from railroad gun believed located vicinity ADAINCOURT Q0545 fell in NANCY between 0200 and 0400 this morning. Intermittent light arty fell in the forward areas during the period.
 2. Aviation - 4 enemy planes reported over area about 1530. One of these planes fired a short burst at one of our liaison planes vicinity JALLAUCOURT - strafing was also reported in the 134th area.
 3. Infantry - Continued counter-patrol activity during hours of darkness.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Estimated enemy casualties 100. Enemy dead buried 5.
- b. Prisoners - 38 PWs had passed thru the Div cage by 1600. Grand total 7,472.
- c. Weather - Continued cloudy this afternoon, tonight and tomorrow morning with possible showers tomorrow afternoon.
- d. Password - WALKER reply HOUND from 121200 October to 131200 October 1944.
- e. Miscellaneous - See overlay for security control of civilians.
- f. CT Mueller which consisted of approximately 150 men and 6 tanks was given the mission to capture FOSSIEUX on 9 October 1944. At least 100 men were either captured or killed and 5 of the 6 tanks were definitely knocked out. Lt. Mueller was captured.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
