1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - See overlay.
- b. Defensive organization - Pillbox reported vicinity Q618605. See 1/25,000, 2d edition, defensive overprints, and overlay attached to this report.
- c. Units in contact - See overlay and OB sketch attached.
- d. Artillery - An enemy battery location, previously unreported, vicinity Q570635.
- e. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - See OB sketch attached.
- f. Supply and Administrative Elements - See overlay for possible and reported CP locations.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - Enemy continued to defend from positions as shown on overlay, and local counter-attacks were reported forming in woods vicinity Q560617 and 583605.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 1. Armor - Three tanks moved W out of woods from Q560617 towards BLIESMENGEN Q5461. About 1215 these tanks moved towards the E back to the woods - 2 of these tanks were hit by our TDs and the other tank went into the woods at Q560617.
 2. Artillery - Enemy artillery fire decreased during the period, concentrations reported vicinity FRAUENBERG Q5559, BLIESBRUCK Q5957, 571563, 595597, 507568 and 568612.
 3. Aviation - A small number of enemy planes were reported N of our sector about 1520 this afternoon.
 4. Infantry - About 80 infantry supported the movement of the 3 tanks in woods vicinity Q560617. About 50 infantry attempted to move S vicinity Q575603 about 1245. Both of these movements were broken up. Infantry in other sectors continues to defend as shown on overlay.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Estimated enemy casualties 200. 2 enemy dead buried.
- b. Prisoners - 160 PWs had passed thru Div cage since 1600. Total for this operation 1,056. Grand total 10,877.
- c. Weather - Cloudy tonight with fog tomorrow morning clearing late in the morning and becoming partly cloudy with no precipitation predicted. Little change in temperature.
- d. Password - ANTONY reply CLEOPATRA from 161200 to 171200 December 1944.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.

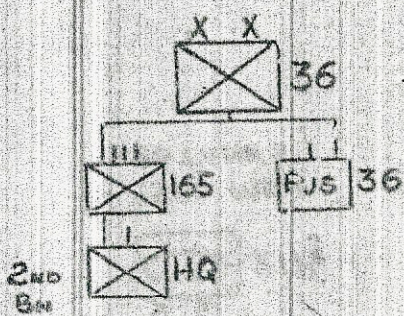

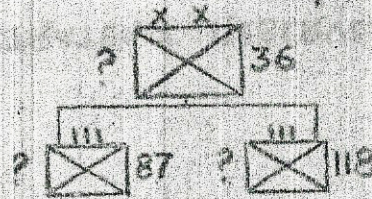

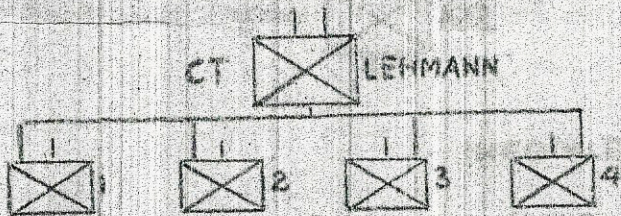


TOTAL 325 Men

IMMEDIATE RESERVES

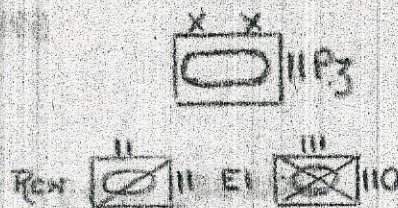


320th SECTOR
