1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - There is no organized front line located in our sector, but the nearest elements are as shown on overlay.
- b. Defensive organization - See overlay. There are fox holes located along the anti-tank ditch to our front as shown on overlay.
- c. Units in contact - See Order of Battle Chart attached to G-2 Periodic Report No. 129.
- d. Artillery - See overlay.
- e. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - See Order of Battle Chart attached to Periodic Report No. 129.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - No enemy activity of infantry and a decreasing amount of enemy arty fire was reported during the period.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 - 1. Artillery - Arty shelling slackened during the past 24 hours. Arty fire was reported falling in the following areas: 177381 - 214332 - 174383 - 193364 and 176380. Most of this fire continues to be of a harassing nature and probably unobserved.
 - 2. Aviation - Two ME-109s were reported over BARONVILLE 1737 at 1350. No bombing or strafing was reported.
 - 3. Infantry - Light mortar fire fell in the forward areas during the period.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Estimated enemy casualties 50. 11 Enemy dead buried.
- b. Prisoners - 27 PWs had passed thru Div cage at 1600. Total for this operation 1,623. Grand total 9,121.
- c. Weather - Cloudy with rain during the night continuing into the morning with some snow likely during the night and little change in temperature.
- d. Password - GENERAL reply ELECTRIC from 181200 to 191200 November 1944.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES:

- a. Enemy can defend in the sector of the zone of advance of the Div with remnants of the 558th Div, the 36th Div and the 11th Pz Div.
- b. Enemy can counter-attack any time after 0800 tomorrow with the units mentioned, reinforcing those units with one new Div every day.
- c. Enemy is capable of partially flooding the land from PUTTELANGE 4150 to woods vicinity 4641 by blowing the dams on the lakes to N and W.
