1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - See overlay.
- b. Defensive organization - At the end of period the enemy was strongly defending pill boxes and entrenchments as shown on overlay.
- c. Units in contact - At the end of period our units were in contact with elements of 589th Inf Div, 48th Inf Div and the 11th Pz Div. Elements of these units have been organized in groups of 50 to 60 to attempt to delay our advance.
- d. Artillery - See overlay for location of enemy arty positions.
- e. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - No change. Elements of the 9th Flak Div have been identified on our front. The remainder of this Div may be available as local reserve.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - Enemy strongly defended with MG, mortar and arty fire, organizing their defensive positions on strong points of previously prepared installations and fire from armor and tanks was reported in the sector.
- b. Operations of component elements:
  1. Armor - A small number of tanks reported during the period at the following locations: 242418, 252462, 271445, 263187 and 260420. Armor action was defensive except at 0730 this morning when two tanks supporting infantry attacked vicinity 271445.
  2. Artillery - See overlay.
  3. Aviation - Two ME 109s over area at 1245, came from E to W. No strafing or bombing reported - mission undetermined.
  4. Infantry - Organized groups of infantry defended previously prepared defensive positions.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

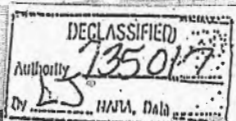
- a. Estimated enemy casualties 200. 4 enemy dead buried.
- b. Prisoners - 27 PWs had passed thru Div cage at 1600. Total for this operation 1,567. Grand total 9,166.
- c. Weather - Scattered clouds tonight and continued overcast with good visibility, continued warm with possible showers at end of period.
- d. Password - WINNEPEG reply QUEBEC from 201200 to 211200 November 1944.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
