1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:
  - a. Enemy front line - No organized front line.
  - b. Units in contact - FWs have been captured from anti-aircraft units, Marsch Units and security personnel.
  - c. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - 1500 Germans were reported moving North to OLIVET 185675 Sof ORLEANS.
2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:
  - a. General summary - Contact with small enemy groups were reported by the Cav.
  - b. Operations of component elements:
    1. Aviation - Unidentified aircraft over the area at approximately 2400 - no bombs or flares were reported.
    2. Infantry - Approximately 200 enemy reported at JANVILLE 655725. Approximately 100 enemy reported at woods 5370. A road between JANVILLE and ALLAINES 6173 is reported covered by the cannon fire of the infantry at JANVILLE.
    3. Tanks - One tank reported woods 5370.
  - c. Miscellaneous - Free French report that the towns of VARIZE 3733, CORMAINVILLE 4467 and ORGERES EN BEAUCHE 5067 have been cleared of enemy.
3. MISCELLANEOUS:
  - a. No enemy casualties and no enemy dead buried during period.
  - b. Prisoners - 83 FWs captured during the period. Grand total 1,644.
  - c. Weather - Continued cloudy with scattered showers during the period.
  - d. Password - CHESTNUT reply STILLETO from 201200 to 211200 August 1944.
4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
