1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - See overlay.
- b. Defensive organization - Enemy defensive positions are located as shown on overlay, and enemy infantry normally defends towns in the zone of our advance.
- c. Units in contact - Scattered elements of 48th Inf Div, 559 Inf Div; 1st Bn 111 Pz Gr Regt and elements of 2nd Bn 111 Pz Gr Regt. The following miscellaneous defensive units have been identified in our sector: 23rd Fortress AT Bn, 681st AT Bn, 817th Hvy MG Bn, 361st AT Bn, 361st Arty (used as AT in support of 11th Pz Div), elements of 106th Pz Brigade, and Ron Bn of 11th Pz Div (4th Co 128th Inf Regt atchd). Tanks from the 15th Pz Regt (11th Pz Div) are separately atchd to the units in our sector.
- d. Artillery - See overlay. It is believed that most arty positions located are from SP or motor drawn arty.
- e. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - PWs report additional fortress bns are being formed and may be committed in our sector. Armor from the 21st Pz Div located on our N is available as reserves in our sector.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - Enemy continued to delay our advance from prepared defensive positions using many mines and road blocks.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 1. Armor - Yesterday afternoon approximately 10 tanks were active in the N sector, and either dug in tanks or SP guns delayed the advance on the N from the strong points.
 2. Artillery - Scattered throughout the period - intense arty fire received in the town of VIRMING 2738 about 2100, direct arty fire received in PELLIMER 3344 this afternoon.
 3. Engineers - See overlay for mine fields located. Dam at lake vic 2439 was prepared for demolition with teller mines one of which has been blown.
 4. Infantry - Units of infantry delayed our advance from defensive positions.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Estimated enemy casualties 125. 16 enemy dead buried.
- b. Prisoners - 224 PWs had passed thru Div cage at 1600. Total for this operation 1,891. Grand total 9,389.
- c. Weather - Continued cloudy with scattered showers tonight and tomorrow with little change in temperature.
- d. Password - ACADEMY reply MILITARY from 211200 to 221200 November 1944.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
