1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:
  - a. Enemy front line - Enemy withdrew from PITHIVIERS at 2400 leaving undefended mines and road blocks.
  - b. Units in contact - Only contact with enemy was on left flank at MALESHERBES X-0580.
  - c. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - No change.
2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:
  - a. General summary - Enemy withdrew from PITHIVIERS to the N and NE at 2400.
  - b. Operations of component elements:
    1. Engineers - It is believed that the troops at PITHIVIERS were composed at least partially of Engineer Troops. Unguarded mines and road blocks were encountered on the roads leading into the town and E of the town of PITHIVIERS.
3. MISCELLANEOUS:
  - a. No enemy dead buried during the period. No enemy casualties reported.
  - b. Prisoners - 16 PWs captured during the period. Grand total 1,663.
  - c. Weather - Intermittent rain this afternoon clearing by morning with little change in temperature.
  - d. Password - MIRROR reply IMAGE from 221200 to 231200 August 1944.
4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
