1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- Enemy front line - See overlay.
- Defensive organization - Our night patrols continue to make contact with the enemy on the N and E as shown on overlay.
- Units in contact - No change.
- Artillery - Most of the arty which fell in area was fired from single runs which indicates the use of self-propelled arty from possible positions as shown on overlay.
- Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - No further reports of enemy vicinity LIOCOURT 09835 or DIEUZE 22524.
- Supply and administrative elements - During the hours of darkness enemy use the road SALOMNES to CHATEAU SALIES sporadically, and also use the roads to the N and NW of FRESNES for supply purposes.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- General summary - There was decreased enemy arty fire during the period and the enemy continued counter-patrol activities during the hours of darkness.
- Operations of component elements:
 - Artillery - Approximately 40 rounds of 88, 75 and 105mm arty fire fell in the following areas: 002254, 034266, 025263, and 976250. No indications of strengthening or lessening of arty in our area.
 - Aviation - Unidentified plane flew over area at approximately 1745, and it is reported that a man parachuted out of this plane into the FORET DE GREMECEY. Two unidentified aircraft were over the sector about 1915. All efforts to locate any parachutist in the FORET DE GREMECEY have failed.
 - Supply and administrative elements - Vehicles reported by patrols last night vicinity COUTURES 00825. At 0430 this morning a column of vehicles also reported moving into FRESNES.
 - Miscellaneous - One jet-propelled flying bomb landed vicinity 875164 at approximately 1300 coming from the NE.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- Estimated enemy casualties 50. Enemy dead buried 25.
- Prisoners - No PWs had passed thru the Div cage by 1600. Grand total 7,429.
- Weather - Cloudy with possible intermittent showers tonight, fog tomorrow morning remaining until late in the period.
- Miscellaneous - General Marshall left this Theater approximately 15 October 1944. His visit may now be mentioned in correspondence.
- Password - WHISTLING reply SPAN from 231200 October to 241200 October 1944.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
