## 1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - There is no organized front line in our sector - see overlay for nearest elements.
- b. Defensive organization - See overlay.
- c. Units in contact - PWs were captured during the period from 559 Inf Div and from the 11 Pz Div. PWs also were captured from the 37 and 38 Regts of the 17 SS Div.
- d. Artillery - Enemy arty fire was received during the period from positions as shown on overlay.
- e. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - Remnants of the 17 SS Div, elements of 347 Inf Div and elements of 106 (Pz Lehr) Div are available as reserves in our sector.

## 2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - Enemy continued defensive action with infantry, arty and a few tanks launching limited counterattack yesterday evening at HILSPRICH 3946.
- b. Operations of component elements:
  - 1. Armor - Four to six tanks plus a company of infantry attacked HILSPRICH about 2130 yesterday. Two tanks and three half-tracks were reported vic Hill 246 (401429) at approximately 1830, and were reported withdrawing to vic 410424 at end of period.
  - 2. Artillery - Medium arty fire fell in the towns along roads and bridges in the forward areas. Five rounds of estimated 170 caliber arty fell in MORHANGE 1936 last night.
  - 3. Engineers - Enemy engineers continued to delay by destroying bridges at 349421, 368409 and 395419.
  - 4. Infantry - Continued to defend strong points and counterattacked at HILSPRICH as stated above.
  - 5. Miscellaneous - PW from 11 Pz Div states that unit received order to withdraw 30 to 40 km to the E the night of 23-24 November.

## 3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Estimated enemy casualties 100. 2 enemy dead buried.
- b. Prisoners - 23 PWs had passed thru Div cage at 1600. Total for this operation 2,144. Grand total 9,642.
- c. Weather - Continued cloudy with intermittent light showers throughout the period with little change in temperature.
- d. Miscellaneous - Civilians will not be allowed to wear any outer garment of the German uniform including boots, and any civilian observed wearing such garments will be investigated by the CIC.
- e. Password - CONSTANTINOPEL reply TURKEY from 251200 to 261200 November 1944.

## 4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
