1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - The enemy has no organized front line in our sector.
- b. Defensive organization - No defensive position located as far east as JOIGNY 08030.
- c. Units in contact - In addition to the 758th Inf Regt of the 338th Div the 9th Regt of the 11th Armd Div, 348th Marsch Bn were also identified today. Also the 9th Co of the 921st Regt 243d Div and elements of the 708th Eng Bn and 728th Regt of the 708th Div were identified.
- d. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - The remnants of the 243d Div and 708th Div are in this area and are capable of interfering with the movement of this organization to the North and East.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING THE PERIOD:

- a. General summary - Small scattered groups of enemy were encountered to the E and SE of JOIGNY; 200 prisoners were reported to have been captured in this area since arrival of one Regimental CT at this location. No new identifications are available on this group of prisoners.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 1. Artillery - One Btry was reported in position at G425220.
 2. Miscellaneous - French civilians report 150-200 Germans in woods G425220. Friendly air reports 40 horsedrawn vehicles moving S and E from AILLANT-SUR-THOLON G755200.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Estimated enemy casualties 20, enemy dead buried none.
- b. Prisoners - 168 PWs captured during period. Grand total 2,608.
- c. Weather - Partly cloudy tomorrow morning becoming clear by mid-day. Little change in temperature.
- d. Password - NORTHERN reply LIGHTS from 261200 to 271200 August 1944.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
