1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- Enemy nearest elements - See overlay. Enemy activity is reported to our N and E outside of the Division sector.
- Defensive organization - See mine map overlay attached.
- Units in contact - Only contact with enemy is with stragglers of the 553d Inf Div and other miscellaneous units previously identified in our sector.
- Artillery - See overlay.
- Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - 1125th and 1126th Regts of the 559th Div, previously reported moving to the S, have not yet been identified in our sector. Reports indicate that the 113 Pz Brigade is located in the FORET-DE-CHATEAU SALINS Q1030. An estimated Regt of infantry plus 30 tanks and artillery are believed located in FORET-DE-PARROY Q1708. Reports also indicate that the 3d SS Pz Gren Regt plus tanks are moving to the W from vicinity of Q2520.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- General summary - Intermittent artillery fire fell in the 134th area last night. In the Corps sector the enemy is moving forces towards the S and W.
- Operations of component elements:
  - Artillery - Intermittent artillery fire fell in 134th area last night.
  - Armor - COA of 4th Armd reports that infantry and 30 to 40 tanks are concentrated vicinity of MARSAL Q1722. Considerable enemy activity is also reported in that area.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- Estimated enemy casualties 50. Enemy dead buried 26.
- Prisoners - 59 PWs captured during the period. Grand total 6,642.
- Weather - Continued cloudy with scattered showers tonight and during period tomorrow.
- Password - WILLIAM reply WALLACE from 261200 September to 271200 September 1944.
- Miscellaneous - Engineers report that the enemy is more thorough with his road blocks and mines than in any other area encountered.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES:

Enemy can attack from the E or SE at any time after 1800 in the sector of the Division with the estimated two Regts of infantry plus 60 tanks in the vicinity of FORET-DE-CHATEAU SALINS, with a Regt of infantry and 30 tanks from the FORET-DE-PARROY and with the tanks and infantry now reported by the 4th Armd Div at their front.
