G-2 PERIODIC REPORT

1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- Enemy front line - See overlay.
- Units in contact - 6th Cav Sqd reports the capture of an enemy patrol from 14th Co, 13th Para Regt, 5th Para Div. PW interrogation revealed that two other Cos of this same Regt occupies sector N of the SURE RIVER in the Div sector.
- Artillery - 6th Cav Sqd reports receiving no artillery and very little mortar fire.
- Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - Elements of the 15th Para Regt, 5th Pz Div have been identified vicinity P575455. One Bn of this Regt may be employed in the Div sector at any time after the Div units advance beyond the SURE RIVER.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- General summary - The 6th Cav Sqd reports receiving small arms fire in area vicinity P585442, little enemy activity was reported in the right portion of the Div sector.
- Operations of component elements:
  - Anti-tank units - Elements of the 911 Brig have been reported vicinity P630449.
  - Artillery - No artillery fire has been received by the 6th Cav in the last 24 hours; however, elements of CCA, 4th AD, report receiving heavy artillery fire from vicinity P6550.
  - Aviation - CCB, 4th AD, reports receiving strafing and bombing attack from enemy aircraft.
  - Infantry - 6th Cav Sqd reports small arms fire from N bank of SURE RIVER P565436. Estimate 3 Cos of enemy infantry occupy N bank of SURE RIVER in the Div sector. The strength of each Co estimated at 100 men.
  - Tanks - No tanks were reported in Div sector, however, SP fire was received by the 4th AD vicinity P5550.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- Weather - Continued clear and cold, scattered clouds at high levels. Visibility unlimited.
- Password - OFFICIAL reply ATTENDANCE from 271200 to 281200 December 1944.
- Miscellaneous - Aircraft should be identified by the hostile act method. A hostile act is interpreted to mean any action that can be interpreted as aggressive action against our troops, such as diving on troop positions or peeling off from formation.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES - No change.
