1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - The enemy has no organized front line in our sector.
- b. Defensive organization - No defensive position has been located, except the local defensive positions of scattered units.
- c. Units in contact - PWs continue to be captured from the 758th Regt a part of the 338th Div, and the 728th Regt, part of the 708th Div. In addition many PWs have been captured from the Marsch Bns located in this sector.
- d. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - No change.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - Enemy south of our sector is moving to the E, SE and NE. See overlay.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 1. Artillery - See movement of troops on overlay.
 2. Infantry - See overlay.
 3. Tanks - See overlay.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Estimated enemy casualties 20, enemy dead buried none.
- b. Prisoners - 1,134 PWs captured during period. Grand total 3,742.
- c. Weather - Continued cloudy with thundershowers tonight and tomorrow morning.
- d. Password - CHELSEA reply FRANCE from 271200 to 281200 August 1944.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.

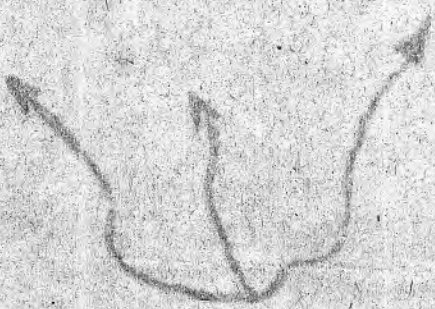
