1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- Enemy front line - No change. 80th Div and 26th Div report scattered enemy resistance in the zone of their advance.
- Defensive organization - No change. See enemy use of mine illustration atchd.
- Units in contact - No contact. PWs captured during period from 17th SS Div.
- Artillery - Arty positions in the N continue to shell REMERING Q4148.
- Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - No change.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- General summary - Very sporadic light arty fell in our area during the period, enemy continues to delay in the XII Corps sector.
- Operations of component elements:
 - Artillery - Sporadic arty fire fell vic KAPPELKINGER 396418 about 1930 yesterday. Corps reports rather intense arty fire vic REMERING.
 - Engineers - SHAEF reports new methods of placing enemy mines. See atchd sheet.
 - Infantry - The 80th Div and the 26th Div report scattered resistance in the zone of their advance.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- Estimated enemy casualties 25. 2 enemy dead buried.
- Prisoners - 30 PWs had passed thru Div cage at 1600. Total for this operation 2,265. Grand total 9,763.
- Weather - Cloudy tonight and tomorrow morning with intermittent rain or light snow tomorrow afternoon - little change in temperature.
- Miscellaneous - Personnel whose bn or separate company headquarters is more than 25 miles from NANCY may mention in personal correspondence that they have visited that city.
- Password - AUGUSTA reply MAINE from 281200 to 291200 November 1944.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.



ANTI-LIFTING PRESSURE RELEASE DEVICE



It has been noticed that the letter "H" was marked on houses & lam posts in vic of S-mines.
