1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - The enemy has no organized front line in the sector of this Division.
- b. Defensive organization - No defensive position has been located, however, small concentrations of troops have been reported at MANSILLY F7608 and VOZON L7895.
- c. Units in contact - See Periodic Report No. 47. No new identifications have been reported.
- d. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - Enemy column containing infantry and field-artillery, estimated to be one Regt, passed thru MOLOSME H2722, moving in a south-easterly direction. This force could be used on the S and E flank of the Division sector at any time.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - Enemy continued his movement to the E, SE and NE during the period covered by this report. No contact with the enemy has been reported.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 1. Artillery - FFI report 300 enemy at ARGENT-SUR-SAULDRY M0985. Enemy was reported to have heavy artillery.
 2. Tanks - A tank column was reported by 3d Army Information Service to be moving toward TROYES Y2875 at 1430.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Estimated enemy casualties 10, enemy dead buried none.
- b. Prisoners - 213 PWs captured during period. Grand total 3,956.
- c. Weather - Cloudy to broken clouds during the morning with ground fog until noon, becoming clear in afternoon and remaining during period.
- d. Password - WAMPUM reply INDIAN from 281200 to 291200 August 1944.
- e. Information has been received from Twelfth Army Group that markings on cowling, wings and empennage on fighter and fighter bomber aircraft of the Ninth Air Force have been discontinued effective 17 August 1944.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
