1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - See overlay for nearest elements in contact in our sector.
- b. Units in contact - Elements of the 13th Para Regt in front of the 320th Inf and elements of the 15th Para Regt in front of the 137th Inf.

- c. Artillery - See overlay for located artillery positions.
- d. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - Elements of the 26th VG Div has been identified in the 4th AD sector. Elements of the 9th VG Div has been identified in the 26th Div sector. Elements of these divisions are available as reserves in our sector.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - Enemy defended with intense small arms fire and moderate mortar and SP fire in the sector of the advance of the Div.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 1. Armor - No armor contacted by Div units. Tank concentration (15 half-tracks and 15 tanks) reported yesterday vicinity P6860 now appear to have been abandoned.
 2. Artillery - 10 rounds of artillery fell vicinity P620452 at 1030 this morning. Artillery from SP guns was received from positions as shown on overlay. Nebelwerfer fire from positions in left of sector.
 3. Aviation - Single unidentified aircraft were over the area last night.
 4. Infantry - MG and small arms fire received from the following locations: P616470, 625482, and 625492 and vicinity 580498. See overlay. Enemy infantry delayed our advance during the period.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Estimated enemy casualties 100. No enemy dead buried.
- b. Prisoners - 72 PWs had passed thru Div cage at 1600. Grand total 11,406.
- c. Weather - Cloudy to partly cloudy tonight and tomorrow with little change in temperature.
- d. Miscellaneous - Four bottles of acid were found in a dump in ARSDORF P640418. Instructions on these bottles state that the wax top is to be broken and the contents thrown.
- e. Password - REVOLUTION reply FRENCH from 291200 to 301200 December 1944.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
