1. ARMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - No change.
- b. Defensive organization - Our patrols during the hours of darkness continue to contact enemy defensive positions on the N and E.
- c. Units in contact - No change.
- d. Artillery - SP guns fire into our sector from concealed positions on the N and E.
- e. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - No change.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:
- a. General summary - Enemy continued defensive action and harassed our forward elements with sporadic arty fire.
 - b. Operations of component elements:
 - 1. Artillery - Light concentrations of arty fell in the following areas: 967290, 049203, 046264, 049203 and vicinity VANHOUE U9726. From these concentrations approximately 20 duds were reported. Smoke shells were reported landing this morning vicinity VANHOUE and ARRAYE ET HAN U9427.
 - 2. Aviation - At approximately 1630 one enemy aircraft was reported strafing vicinity Q0423. Two Fw-190's were reported over the area around 1300. No bombing or strafing was reported.
 - 3. Miscellaneous - Enemy continued to harass forward units with sporadic mortar fire and employed counter patrol activities during the hours of darkness.

3. MISCELLANEOUS

- MISCELLANEOUS:
- a. Estimated enemy casualties 25. Five enemy dead buried.
 - b. Prisoners - No PWs had been captured during the period. Grand total 7,492.
 - c. Weather - Continued fair and cold throughout period with no precipitation.
 - d. Password - CHEESE reply GAKE from 301200 to 311200 October 1944.

4. EMPTY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
