1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - Corps reports that on our flank the units are meeting resistance from a line north of and parallel to Highway No. 3.
- b. Defensive organization - See overlay also mine clearance operations as reported 292000 July by 60th Engr Bn.
- c. Units in contact - Our left unit captured PWs from the 8th and 15th Para. Regt. and 352d Fus. Bn.
- d. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - No change.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - The enemy continued to withdraw leaving behind only those soldiers who were out of contact with their units.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 - 1. Artillery - Light artillery fell in the forward areas during the period.
 - 2. Aviation - Between 2241 and 2304 at least 8 enemy planes were over the area dropping flares, bombs and anti-personnel bombs. ST. LO was bombed during that period.
 - 3. Infantry - Enemy withdrew during the entire period.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Total of 59 PWs captured during the period. Total for operation 740.
- b. Weather - Light drizzle predicted for tomorrow morning and little change in temperature.
- c. Password - WARDEN reply WAMPUM from 1200 30 July to 1200 31 July 1944.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: No change.
