1. **ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:**

- a. Enemy front line - The enemy has no organized front line in the sector of this Div.
- b. Defensive organization - Enemy outposted LUSIGNY - SUR - PARSE (Y4267) until he could clear his route of withdrawal through VENDEUVRE - SUR - PARSE (Y5764). Civilians report enemy column approximately 10 hours long cleared VENDEUVRE - SUR - PARSE at 300700 outpost placed at LUSIGNY - SUR - PARSE followed.
- c. Units in contact - PWs of units listed in G-2 Periodic Reports No. 49 and 50 continue to be captured during period covered by this report. Units of this Div advanced approximately 20 km during the period without contact with enemy other than light mortar fire from outpost at LUSIGNY - SUR - PARSE.
- d. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - FPI continues to report presence of enemy force est 1 Bn S of ORLEANS. This force is est to be no immediate threat to the Div forces in that sector. However, they are capable of harassing missions across the river to the N at any time.

2. **ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:**

- a. General summary - Enemy continued to withdraw his forces to the N and NE covering his withdrawal with small forces in sector of the Div.
- b. Miscellaneous - Heavy German traffic reported moving E and N on BOURGES, CHARITE, BARZY, CHAMEGY ROAD. 40 tanks were reported 15 km SE of BOURGES at 1140.

3. **MISCELLANEOUS:**

- a. One German casualty was reported during period covered by this report. Enemy dead buried none.
- b. Morale of all PWs interrogated is very low.
- c. Prisoners - 37 PWs captured during period. Grand total 4,403.
- d. Weather - Cloudy with continued scattered showers throughout period.
- e. Password - TRAILER reply HALFTRACK from 311200 August to 011200 September 1944.

4. **ENEMY CAPABILITIES - No change.**
