1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:
 - a. Enemy front line - Only contact with enemy at [blank] on our left front vicinity 610344.
 - b. Defensive organization - No contact except as indicated.
 - c. Units in contact - Small groups of various units in contact only on our extreme left front.
 - d. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - No change.
2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:
 - a. General summary - The enemy hurriedly withdrew from previously reported defensive positions.
 - b. Operations of component elements:
 1. Artillery - Our left unit received fairly accurate artillery fire in the latter period of its advance.
 2. Infantry - Hurriedly withdrew from previous defensive positions.
3. MISCELLANEOUS:
 - a. Total of 12 PWs captured during period. Total for operation 859.
 - b. Weather - Fair tomorrow and continued warm.
 - c. Password - WHALLOP reply PUNCH. The following procedure will be used for challenging:
 The sentinel challenges, "Halt who's there." The person challenged then gives his identity. The sentinel then advances the person challenged and orders "Give the password." The person challenged then gives the password in a low tone (WHALLOP during the next 24 hour period) and may ask the sentinel for the reply.
4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: No change.
