1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- Enemy front line - No change.
- Defensive organization - Patrols report area between 001278 to 005275 is booby trapped - Patrols found many trip wires this location. See enemy obstacle overlay attached. No change reported in defensive organization.
- Units in contact - PW captured from 3d Co, 1125 Regt between MALAUCOURT and JALLAUCOURT. PW states the 1st Co is on the W and 2d Co is on the E of the 3d Co. 1st and 2d Bns, 1125 Regt identified on our N and 1st and 2d Bns, 1127 Regt have been identified on our E. One enemy btry located
- Artillery - One enemy btry located 04253194, and 2 105's located 09602535.
- Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - General reserve 11th Pz Div, possible immediate reserve 1126 Regt.
- Supply and Administrative elements - PW states that 1st Bn 1125 Regt receives supplies from VIVIERS 0433.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- General summary - Enemy continues defensive action and active arty fire into our sector.
- Operations of component elements:
 - Artillery - Approximately 90 rounds of arty, consisting 88's and 105, fell in the Div sector during the period. Air photos located approximately 50 AA guns vicinity Hill 281 0732.
 - Aviation - At least 3 enemy aircraft over the sector between 2230 and 2400.
 - Armor - Of 15 armored vehicles reported Q102222, Air reports that there are only 4 left this morning which two are disabled. It is believed that the other vehicles moved in north-easterly direction.
 - Engineers - French report that mines on roads from CHATEAU SALINS to COURETRES and from CHATEAU SALINS to CHAMPREY have been removed. French also report mines located at RJ 096261 and RR bridge 104252 and grade crossing 092272.
 - Infantry - Continue defensive action - increased flare activity and patrols in the N were also reported.
 - Supply and Administrative elements - Horse-drawn vehicles come from VIVIERS to MALAUCOURT and JALLAUCOURT about 2000 and supply one warm meal.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- Estimated enemy casualties 35. No enemy dead buried.
- Prisoners - 1 PW had passed thru Div Enclosure at 1600. Grand total 7,498.
- Artillery reports 3 enemy arty pieces probably destroyed at 04253194.
- Weather - Scattered showers tonight and tomorrow afternoon.
- Password - VIRGINIA reply GEORGIA from 071200 to 081200 November 1944.

ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
