1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - See overlay.
- b. Defensive organization - See overlay. Additional road block with mines reported at 971322. Additional digging in reported in edge of woods vicinity 072270.
- c. Units in contact - 1st and 2d Bns of 1125 Regt on the N and 1st and 2d Bns of 1127 Regt on the E.
- d. Artillery - Enemy btry locations reported at 04643072, 02983030 and 02833129. See overlay.
- e. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - The 11th Pz Div, re-organized, is available as reserve anywhere in the Corps sector. 1126 Regt, not definitely located, is believed available as immediate reserve in our sector.
- f. Supply and administrative elements - See overlay.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - Enemy continues defensive action with greatly increased amount of enemy arty.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 1. Artillery - Between 1825 and 1945 more than 400 rounds of 105, 88 arty fire fell in the following areas: 150 rounds at 018227, 150 rounds at 005235, 50 rounds at 003230, 20 rounds at 041235 and 20 rounds at 9923.
 2. Aviation - Single unidentified aircraft were reported over the area between 2015 and 2130 and between 0230 and 0330.
 3. Engineers - Enemy defensive installations shown on overlay Periodic Report 119 vicinity HAN 9626 has been reported cleared.
 4. Infantry - A great amount of enemy foot activity reported vicinity JALLAUCOURT at 1035 this morning. Mortar and MG fire were received during the period from the JUREE WOODS.
 5. Supply and administrative elements - Truck movement last night reported between VALUCOURT and JALLAUCOURT.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Estimated enemy casualties 25. No enemy dead buried.
- b. Prisoners - No PWs had passed thru Div Enclosure at 1600. Grand total 7,498.
- c. Three enemy batteries believed neutralized at 046307, 029303 and 028325.
- d. Weather - Cloudy throughout period with precipitation this evening clearing somewhat tomorrow morning with precipitation again in the afternoon. No change in temperature. Poor to fair visibility throughout period.
- e. Password - VERMONT reply CHAMPLAIN from 081200 to 091200 November 1944.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES:

- a. Enemy can defend his present position with one Regt on the N and one Regt on the E, employing one Regt as local reserve in the Div sector, and one Pz Div as strategic reserve in the Corps sector.
- b. Enemy can counter attack in Div sector with the forces indicated above.
