1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - Ron troop reached phase line R meeting only scattered resistance as shown on overlay.
- b. Defensive organization - No defensive organization as such has been encountered.
- c. Units in contact - Small unidentified units reported in contact.
- d. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - Reserves which may be committed in our sector include elements of the 2nd SS, the 17th SS, 708th and 130th Pz Lehr Divisions.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - Small disorganized and separate enemy groups attempted to delay our advance.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 1. Aviation - Enemy aircraft were over the area the early part of period dropping bombs and causing some casualties vicinity ST CLAIRES DU MARCOURT. Enemy aircraft were also over the area in strength between 2230 and 2400 - no bombing or strafing was reported.
 2. Infantry - Infantry fired on our forces from positions shown on overlay.
 3. Tanks - One tank was reported vicinity 5605.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Total of 7 PWs captured during the period. Total for last operation 859. Grand total 866.
- b. Weather - Overcast in the morning clearing later and continued warm.
