1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - see overlay.
- b. Defensive organization - no change.
- c. Units in contact - see overlay.
- d. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention. No indications of reinforcements on our immediate front. Believed the 277 Inf Div moving into general area from S of FRANCE.
- e. Supply and evacuation establishments. Supplies are being unloaded at ST. THOMAS DE ST LO 4961 and brought up from main supply depot at RENNES.

2. ENEMY OPERATION DURING PERIOD.

- a. General summary. Enemy patrolling was reduced but there was continued counter-patrolling measures.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 1. Armored forces: A limited attack was repulsed in area of 30th Div (See overlay)
 2. Artillery: Light harassing artillery fire in our zone.
 3. Tanks: Tanks supported attack on 30th Div. Mark IVs identified and estimated 5 enemy tanks were destroyed.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. No PWs taken. No enemy dead buried.
- b. Weather: Scattered showers tomorrow afternoon, visibility good with little change in temperature.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES:

- a. Enemy can continue to defend with forces shown on overlay with limited counterattacks.
- b. Enemy can attack reinforced by GHQ artillery and tank troops reinforced by the 277th Div on its arrival in this sector.
