1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

The Division was not in contact with the enemy during the period.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

The units of the Division throughout the period continued to round up and evacuate thru PW channels members of the enemy armed forces and individuals who had been classified as security threats.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

a. Prisoners - 414 PWs passed thru the Division cage during the period. Total for this operation 1,478. Grand total 28,368.

b. Miscellaneous - 28 Hitler Jugend members, 13 to 18 years old, were apprehended in general area C5060 by 17th Engr Bn through information gained from civilian sources. Hitler Jugend were well armed with pistols, were banded together, and contemplated sabotage. These Hitler Jugend are being tried today by Military Government. (See: 2nd Armd Div Int Bul #4)

Two Germans in a French car No. 360469 wearing American helmets and shirts, and German jackets have been observed in the 2nd Armd Div zone. The 2 men are between 22 and 25 years old and are armed with rifles and pistols. (See: 30th Inf Div G-2 Rpt)

One of our regiments occupying the west bank of the Rhine reports that it places ladders across a gap in a blown bridge for an hour each morning and evening and ushers through our lines those of the crowd assembled on the east bank who are eligible by virtue of uniform to become PWs. When all uniformed personnel have been received, the ladders are pulled in. Civilians and soldiers who were so thoughtless as to destroy their uniforms, remain milling on the far shore. It is said that these folk have the appearance of ones suffering from an ache of conscience. (See: 2d Inf Div - Thru G-2 Rpt #309 1st Div)

c. Weather - Continued cloudy to partly cloudy tonight and tomorrow with possible light showers throughout the period. Little change in temperature.

d. Password - WALK reply ALONE from 021200 to 031200 May 1945.
