ANNEX NO. 1 - To accompany Unit Report No. 28, 1 July 1945.

WANTED PERSONS

WESTPHAL, Gustav - Born 25 October 1925, 5'6" tall, dark eyes, side-burns, dark brown wavy hair. His right arm gives the appearance of a droop. He is an ex-sailor. When he escaped he was wearing blue clothing with black-seated naval type trousers, naval type pull-over, and jack boots.

BREESE, Wilhelm - Born 20 May 1924, 5'6" tall, dark brown wavy hair, slant eyes. He is an ex-soldier. When he escaped he was wearing grey riding breeches with blue diagonal, grey riding boots, and a wrist watch with a black face.

GARTHE, Arnold Frederick, @ JENSEN, @ PATRICK @ HERMANN.

GIS Career: Abwehr official; Oberst, Luftwaffe; Leiter, I Luft, Aist PARIS, 1941-43; Leiter, Ast LYONS, 1943-44; Reported Leiter, Aust SAKRBRUCKEN, under Ast WIESBADEN (1944); also reported Leiter I A, Aist PARTS (July 1944).

DESCRIPTION: Born 10 Sept 1893, Port Elizabeth, South Africa. (Father German, Mother English) Height 5'5"; stout; slightly pot-bellied; round face; prominent nose; double chin; hair somewhat curly, parted, but cut short; clear lively eyes; jovial and amiable; nervous; hypochondriac; never wears a hat; very English in appearance; speaks perfect English; speaks German with a slight English accent; suffering from heart trouble.

RECENT MOVEMENTS - Had a falling out with Nazi leaders in 1944. Went to WIESBADEN and entered a hospital for treating for Angina Pectoris. With bombing of WIESBADEN, 2 Feb 1945, went to MUNICH and entered a hospital at BAD TOELZ. Discharged from hospital 4 April 1945 and went to home of brother in LANGWEID, BEI MUENCHEN. With military emergency he was sent to BAD AIRLING in command of a Luftwaffe unit. Last known to be in BAD AIRLING in April, 1945. Thereafter presumed to have been taken prisoner or to have entered a hospital.

DILLI, Gustav - Ministerialdirektor, Chief of Operations in the Railways Transportation Ministry at BERLIN.

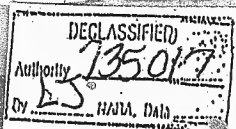

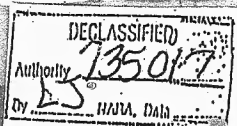
APPREHENSION OF HEITMEYER AND GENERAL CZECH:

As a result of interrogating prisoner of war, Colonel Rommel, a Luftwaffe mine design expert now in the UK, an individual named HEITMEYER is now wanted for interrogation. The branch of service and the rank of HEITMEYER is not known by this headquarters. Information from Supreme Headquarters states HEITMEYER may be wearing the uniform of a Luftwaffe Lieutenant, an Engineer Major, or just plain clothes. He was last heard of on 5 May when he was reported to be on the yacht "Atlanta", in an unidentified German port. He had orders to take to JAPAN complete details of latest mine developments including the type "Oyster". A Luftwaffe mine expert, General CZECH, may be with HEITMEYER. These two men and anyone accompanying them should be detained. (See: Ltr, 12th Army Group, 19 June 45)

MISCELLANEOUS:

LOSS OR STEALING OF WALLET AND SHAEF IDENTIFICATION PAPERS:

Trier Sub-Area reports Dutch Liaison Officer (1st Lt Jan Ten Doeschate) working in DP CAMP KEMEL at TRIER L2129, either lost or had stolen, wallet and SHAEF identification papers. If recovered forward to AC of S, G-2, this Hq.

C I C : -

The direction to and the location of CIC Headquarters will be appropriately marked by use of official CIC signs.

ILLEGAL CARRIAGE OF MAIL TO OR FROM GERMANY:

All personnel will be warned to refrain from accepting for onward transmission unauthorized communications to or from persons located in GERMANY or AUSTRIA.

WAFFEN SS ARRESTEES:-

1. Waffen SS personnel who were erroneously discharged by ADSEC will be returned to ADSEC cage with discharge form. PWTE (ADSEC) cage is located south of RINGEN.

2. Waffen SS personnel below automatic arrest category and other than those discharged by ADSEC will be arrested and turned over to nearest Mil Gov't Det for confinement and report to Corps G-1. Arresting authority - CIC or MG will submit duplicate arrest report to Div G-2.
