1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - The units of the Div were not in contact with the enemy at end of period.
- b. Defensive organization - There was no defensive position W of the RHINE RIVER at end of period in the sector of the Div. Air observation reports that the E span of the bridge at A218393 was blown; and that both the E and W span of the railroad bridge at A210404 were blown leaving the center intact.
- c. Units in contact - The 190th Inf Div was the major unit contacted during the period with scattered PWs also taken from the 116th Pz Div, 2nd Para Div, 7th Para Div, and 18th Para Regt of 6th Para Div. Locations of the 190th Inf Div are listed by PWs as follows:

- d. Artillery - No new battery locations were reported during the period. The artillery batteries moved to the E side of the RHINE during the night.
- e. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - No reserves are available in the Div sector W of the RHINE RIVER.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

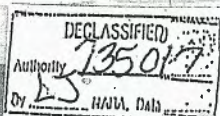
- a. General summary - The bulk of the enemy forces in the Div sector moved S of the RHINE during the night leaving only scattered infantrymen and engineers to delay our advance.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 - 1. Artillery - Intensive artillery fire was reported on the forward elements during the night and sporadic artillery fire was reported from battery positions E of the RHINE RIVER during the day. Sporadic nebelwerfer fire was reported last night.
 - 2. Infantry - Scattered groups of infantry attempted to delay our advance with small arms fire.
 - 3. Miscellaneous - Air observation reported barges leaving from the W bank of the RHINE RIVER vicinity A205374 and moving N and E across the RIVER to A219385 about 0915 this morning.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Estimated enemy casualties 100, 20 of which were killed and 80 long term wounded. 16 enemy dead buried.
- b. Prisoners - 215 PWs passed thru the Div cage during the period. Total for this operation 4,382. Grand total 16,790.
- c. Weather - Broken to overcast clouds during the daytime with possible scattered showers and little change in temperature.

3. MISCELLANEOUS (Continued)

- d. Miscellaneous - Higher headquarters is very anxious to obtain the Easter Code, which is used by all enemy units. A facsimile copy of the code is attached to this report.

Effective immediately the mass arresting of all males between the ages of 17 and 30 years as a security threat will cease. Any person, male or female, of any age, who investigation reveals to be a security threat, will be arrested and together with an arrest slip signed by the CIC showing the nature of the charges, will be delivered to the Div PM for evacuation through IV channels.

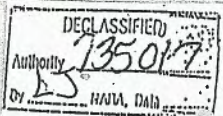
