1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- Enemy front line - Scattered groups of enemy were contacted at end of period in woods at P601548, 601540 and 601535.
- Defensive organization - Small mine fields were reported vicinity P598545, 576537 and 571504.
- Units in contact - Elements of 339th Regt and 331st Regt. PWs taken in the last three days are identified as follows:

d. Artillery - Intermittent SP fire was encountered in the N part of the sector during the period, and small amounts of artillery fire were reported during the period - one concentration was reported about 1800 vicinity P548519. No new battery locations reported.

e. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - Elements of 130th Pz Div, 1st SS Pz Div, 12th SS Pz Div and 340th Div are available as reserves for commitment in our sector.

f. Supply and Administrative Elements - CPs reported at OBERWAMPACH P6559; 612561 and 630557.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- General summary - Enemy withdrew to the N and E leaving a covering force which attempted to delay our advance by small arms, automatic weapons and mortar fire.
- Operations of component elements:-
 - Artillery - See 1 d above.
 - Infantry - Groups of enemy left as covering force defended with small arms, MG and mortar fire.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- Estimated enemy casualties 150, of which 125 were injured and 25 killed. 12 enemy dead buried.
- Prisoners - 94 PWs had passed thru the Div cage since 101600; 42 of these PWs were sent to the Div cage from 6th Cav Gp and do not appear in Div total. Total for this operation 734. Grand total 12,068.
- Weather - Scattered clouds tonight with early morning fog and haze lifting early tomorrow afternoon with little change in temperature.

3. MISCELLANEOUS (Continued):

d. Miscellaneous - IWs interrogated with frozen feet state that they were unable to leave their foxholes because of our intense artillery fire. Pilots and air crews crash-landed in our sector must not be assumed to be Allied Air Forces personnel and such personnel will be sent to the nearest S-2 or G-2 for preliminary interrogation.

Censorship regulations permit correspondence between members of this command and civilians in the liberated areas of North-West Europe. The normal military address is authorized.

e. Password - CADDY reply FEE from 121200 to 131200 January 1945.

4. ENEMY CAPABILITIES: - No change.
