1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- Enemy front line - At end of period only scattered groups of enemy rifle-men were being rounded up in the 134th sector.
- Defensive organization - No organized defensive position contacted. Mine-fields were located vicinity P572506, 581508, 576537 and 598545. These minefields consisted of both anti-tank and anti-personnel mines.
- Units in contact - Scattered elements of 339th Regt, 331st Regt and 14th Para Regt. PWs taken in the last three days identified as follows:

- Artillery - No new battery locations. There are indications that enemy artillery has been withdrawn.
- Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - No change.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- General summary - Scattered groups of enemy attempted to withdraw to the NE during the period.
- Operations of component elements:
 - Artillery - Scattered SP fire was reported in our N sector late yesterday afternoon.
 - Infantry - Small groups defended and then attempted to withdraw to the NE during the period.
 - Miscellaneous - See location of minefields reported in 1 b above.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- Estimated enemy casualties 150, of which 125 were injured and 25 killed, 11 enemy dead buried.
- Prisoners - 26 PWs had passed thru Div cage since 111600. Total for this operation 760. Grand total 12,094.
- Weather - Cloudy to partly cloudy throughout period with scattered snow showers, fog and haze in early morning clearing somewhat later in the day, with little change in temperature.
- Password - WILDCAT reply PANTHER from 131200 to 141200 January 1945.
