1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- Enemy front line - No change.
- Defensive organization - Movement was observed around dugouts vicinity K926752. No change in defensive positions - see 1/25,000 overprinted maps as of 01 Feb 1945.
- Units in contact - Four PWs processed thru PW and medical channels were identified from 3rd Co of the 1218th Regt(176th VC Div). PWs state that the 1218th and 1219th Regts are in the line with the 1220th in reserve. Elements of the 1218th only are in contact in this Div sector, the 1219th Regt is believed to be on the N of the 1218th Regt.
- Artillery - No new battery locations were reported.
- Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - Elements of the 116th Pz Div have now been identified in the British sector to the N, and air reconnaissance today reported approximately 100 armored vehicles vicinity F3441 believed to be the 130th Pz Lehr Div. These identifications make it appear unlikely that these two divisions, formerly reported as reserves available on this Div front, are still available in full as such reserves.
- Supply and Administrative Elements - Ten wagons were observed moving N on road at K91557666 about 1100 today. Two trucks were observed moving N on road into EUCHTENBERG K8977 about 1100 today.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- General summary - Enemy continued defensive action with scattered artillery during period.
- Operations of component elements:
 - Artillery - Seven rounds, estimated caliber 150mm to 240mm, fell vicinity K903690 from 1040 to 1200 today. Six to seven rounds, estimated 88mm, fell vicinity K8671 about 1100.
 - Infantry - Continued defensive action with flare activity reported during the night. Enemy patrols were reported vicinity K8376, 817787, 9073 during the night.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- Prisoners - Four PWs were cleared today thru PW and medical channels. Grand total PWs 12,408.
- Weather - Continued cloudy tonight and tomorrow with little change in temperature.
- Miscellaneous - There has been no appreciable change in the condition of the ROER RIVER and its tributaries during the period. Air observation reports that the only bridges in the Div sector are as follows: (1) A bridge capable of holding motor transport K939727. (2) Foot bridge vicinity K935724.
- Password - LEAVES reply RUSTLING from 141200 to 151200 February 1945.
