1. COUNTERINTELLIGENCE:

In the VII Corps area, communications wire was cut in ESPERSTEDT D4011 and at D429327. During the night, the VIII Corps reported that a prowler had started a fire in a motor pool of the 76th Infantry Division. Investigation revealed that gasoline had been poured over two jeeps in the attempted sabotage. The saboteur made good his escape. (See: Ninth U S Army G-2 Periodic Rpt 246)

At SPRINGE X2402 arrested: Hans SCHNUCKE, Ortspropagandaleiter of SPRINGE; Karl HESSE, Kreispropagandaleiter of Springe Kreis; Richard HOPTNER, Kreisamtsleiter for Kripo; Ernst GRETEN, Kreis technical advisor, Heinrich PRELLE, Kreis Rasse-Politik; Karl BUSSMAN, Ortsgruppenleiter 1934 to 1944, party member from early days of NSDAP.

At MUNDER XI801 arrested; Gustave RICHARD, of Mollenbeck, ortsruppenleiter; Wilhelm KOSTER, of Auhagen, ortsruppenleiter; Edmund HUBRICH, of Auhagen, ortsruppenleiter; Johann WATERMAN, Buchholtz, ortsruppenleiter; Georg DIEDERT, of Rinteln, security threat, fanatical and terroristic Nazi, denounced by German civilians; Eduard SATTELMACHER, of Rinteln, security threat, denounced by German civilians as a fanatical Nazi; Willi KERGER, of Krainhafen, unterscharfuhrer in SS.

At REHER CO282, security survey continued. Arrested: August JURGENS, ortsguppenleiter, Ferdinand Schluter, kassenleiter; Edward FORSTER, organizationleiter; Otto GROTE, schulungsleiter; Dietrich HACHWEISTER, NSV amtsleiter.
