**1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:**

- Enemy front line - No change.
- Defensive organization - Civilians report enemy pillbox at K93787201. See 1/25,000 defensive overprinted map dated 01 February 1945.
- Units in contact - Elements of 183rd VG Div and 176th VG Div, totalling approximately 3,000 to 3,500 men.
- Artillery - No new battery locations were reported during the period.
- Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - Corps estimates that there are two Pz Divs and one VG Div available as reserve in the Corps sector.
- Supply and Administrative Elements - A small number of wheeled ~~trucks~~ were heard last night about 2145 in grid square 9472. The bridge at HILFARTH K9372, it is believed, is still being used for supply and evacuation of enemy troops in that sector.

**2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:**

- General summary - Enemy continued defensive action during the period with sporadic artillery fire reported.
- Operations of component elements:
  - Artillery - Small concentrations of artillery were reported at the following locations: 4 rounds, estimated 105mm, fell vicinity K9069 about 0545; 4 rounds, estimated 105mm, fell vicinity HUNSHOVEN K8764 about 2400; 1 round 105mm fell vicinity K866761 about 1400; 1 round large caliber artillery fell K841743 at 1100; and 3 rounds, estimated 105mm, fell vicinity K879758.
  - Infantry - Continued defensive action with enemy MGs placed to block the advance of our patrols and scattered flare activity during the night. Mortar fire was reported coming from vicinity K883762 and 893744. Enemy movements were reported vicinity K906745 at 1610 and 898748 about 1330.

**3. MISCELLANEOUS:**

- Weather - Continued overcast tonight and tomorrow morning with some breaks in the afternoon and tomorrow evening. Slightly cooler temperatures.
- Password - PEA reply POWL from 201200 to 211200 February 1945.
