ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

Division was not in contact with enemy during the period.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

The units of the Division continued to assemble and evacuate thru PW channels members of the enemy armed forces and individuals who had been classified as security threats.

About 1500 an American officer observed a boy of about 12 years cutting telephone wire vicinity WOODCOLTERN X2017. The boy was not apprehended since he had disappeared into some woods in the vicinity - his parents are being held.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

a. Prisoners - 460 PWs passed thru Division cage during the period. Total for this operation 1,938. Grand total 28,828.

b. Miscellaneous - Spotting the Nazis - 1. Religion: "One indication can be found in the Soldbuch if the man is listed as a Catholic or Protestant, he is probably a lukewarm Nazi at best. If, on the other hand, he is described as a 'Gott-Gläubig' or 'Gott-Glaubig' (believer in God), he is sure to be a Nazi. Catholics and Protestants, it seems, call themselves that; Hitler boys just call themselves believers. 2. First Names: "Another possible indication is the subject's first name. True-blue Nazi parents would never call their offspring anything as degenerate as Hans or Fritz or Herman. They went in for such laryngeal stupefiers as Kunigunde (girl) and Gisela (boy). The prisoner said a 'Gisela' could be put down as a Nazi before he said that he never once fired his rifle at American troops. Other favorite Nazi names for males are Thor, Wotan, Siegfried, Attila, Alaric, Gernot and Tego. Wimmerk, another male favorite, is an alternate spelling of 'Wimmer', so named because Hitler likes it that way. Ute and Uwe are names handed down from the original settlers of the Frisian Islands. On the female side, Unna, Hitlerike, Brunhilde, Krimhilde and Edeltraut are favored by Nazi mothers." (See: G-2 Rpt, XV Corps)

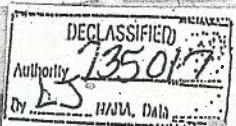
