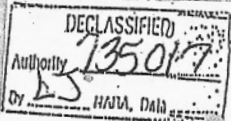

1. RESEARCH OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- The 5th Armd Div is in contact with the Totsdam Div and forced it to withdraw to the N and E. The entire divisional staff surrendered with the exception of the CG who deserted in preference to surrendering.

## 3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Prisoners - 131 PWs passed thru Div cage since 192100. Total for this operation 4,388. Grand total 25,302.
- b. Estimated enemy casualties 20, 5 of which were killed and 15 long term wounded.
- c. Miscellaneous - Two enemy officers and 6 enlisted men were captured vicinity of Y630257 this morning. One of our tanks was destroyed by Panzerfaust fire in this vicinity on the night of 19-20 April.  
Gasoline dump vicinity Y902325 was hit by our artillery and set on fire.

Two PWs captured in vicinity Y7924 report that they were on a mission to locate our artillery positions.

Civilian line crosser reports that the airfield in BURG Y8015 is no longer useable, also that small roads in vicinity of Y7924 are very poor after rain.

Road blocks are reported to be set up vicinity Y772182 and Y765181.

PWs who were captured from the Werewolf organization (See G-2 Periodic Report No. 266) carried the following equipment: 20 blasting caps, 15 pull-type igniters, 55 blocks of TNT (7 ounces), 20 sticks of TNT, 8 grenades, 2- 2 lb blocks of TNT, 18 pull-type firing devices, 30 ft. of primacord, 150 ft. of copper wire (20 gauge), and 75 rounds of 31 caliber ammunition.

- d. Weather - Continued fair with high and middle clouds. Scattered showers near end of period.
- e. Password - BIRD reply CHIRP from 211200 to 221200 April 1945.
