1. COUNTERINTELLIGENCE:

XVI Corps has reported two separate incidents of wire cutting in the Corps sector. The first incident occurred at approximately 151500B May at which time three pieces of four spiral cable were removed from a line in vicinity of A6508. During the afternoon of 16 May, the second incident was reported to have taken place along the same communication line approximately one mile northwest of the first incident and in vicinity of A6210. Investigation is being conducted by 75th Div for the purpose of identifying the responsible person or persons. (See: XVI Corps Special G-2 Per Rpt #101)

Nails were driven into tires of a jeep near MESCHDE B638505 and a tree was blown by demolition charges across the highway at B639510. Investigation has failed to disclose the guilty parties in either instance. (See: Ninth US Army G-2 Per Rpt #254)

2. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Censorship - The following instructions from higher headquarters are published for information to all concerned: Unit censorship of mail and telegrams of all personnel under this command will be discontinued immediately. Base censorship will continue. Unit censor stamps will be retained until further advised.
- b. Miscellaneous - Higher Headquarters reports prominent Germans have engaged in suicide attempts after capture. Necessary measures will be taken to prevent such occurrences. Important prisoners will be stripped and thoroughly searched immediately following capture to determine possession of means of self destruction. Suggest prisoners of Counter Intelligence interest receive special attention as these more likely to possess self destruction materials than others. Invite attention to means such as shoe laces, belts, neckties and watch crystals. (See: TWX XVI Corps, 18 May 45)

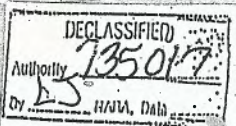
