1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- Enemy front line - There was no change in the enemy front line along the Corps front. See overlay which accompanied G-2 Periodic Report No. 191 dated 20 January 1945.
- Defensive organization - Corps reports no new defensive positions located.
- Units in contact - 11th Pz Div on the N; 416th Inf Div, 719th Inf Div, and elements of 347th Inf Div on the E.
- Artillery - Corps reports no new arty positions located.
- Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - No change.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- General summary - The local counterattacks reported in yesterday's periodic report via SAARLAUTERN bridgehead Q2981 and via ORSCHOLZ L1201 were repulsed. Enemy was very inactive during the period.
- Operations of component elements:
 - Artillery - Sporadic arty fire was reported in the forward Corps sector during the period.
 - Infantry - See general summary above.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- Grand total of PWs 12,375. Total for last operation 1,041.
- Weather - Clouds breaking tonight and tomorrow with little change in temperature.
- Miscellaneous - Censorship: Personnel are not authorized to state in personal correspondence that they are in Metz; personnel may state that they are "Somewhere in France".
- Password - JUICY reply FRUIT from 221200 to 231200 January 1945.
