1. COUNTERINTELLIGENCE:

A German civilian WILLI BOECKER, was ordered to halt after curfew at a road block A886035. He broke into a run. Guard fired once over his head to no avail. Three more shots were fired. Two bullets went in German's head, one in stomach. BOECKER is now in a military hospital, not expected to live. (See: XVI Corps G-2 Per Rpt #105)

29th Div's BREMEN Task Force reports very optimistically on CI conditions in BREMEN and BREMERHAVEN. The following is quoted from its CI Report No. 1, dated 18 May. The only notable case of resistance organizations yet discovered is the AKTION BLINDSCHNEE, a Werewolf type organization. In this area it appears not to have been completely organized and the taking of the city has deprived it of leaders. Due to the large number of security arrests it is temporarily blinded. Three suspected members are now under arrest and a previous one committed suicide in his cell. (See: XVI Corps G-2 Per Rpt #104)

Telephone wires on the outskirts of NORDHAUSEN D1228 were discovered cut in ten-foot sections over a distance of 100 yards. Attached to one piece of wire was a sheet of white paper with SS markings on the back and the following message written in German:

"Dated 18 May 1945

From: German SS - Gestapo - NSDAP

To : Military Commander of NORDHAUSEN and Burgomeisters of NORDHAUSEN and Burgomeisters of NORDHAUSEN and SALZA D1029.

We wish all three of you a happy Whitsunday. You may dream what you like only don't dream that there are no more Gestapo - NSDAP.

Hitler still lives and his last warriors have not yet fallen. That you have done today you must answer for tomorrow....to the victor who wears the Iron Cross on his chest.

(Signed) Polite greetings from the SS
Heil Hitler"

On the reverse side these words were written:

"The telephone lines will secretly be out of order. Any attempt to apprehend the people who did this will be in vain. You won't find the real Nazis. You will find only those who thoughtfully interpreted Hitler's ideas and who have thoughtfully carried them out. Fate is hard but just." (See: 5th Arm Div, Thru: VII Corps)

a. Miscellaneous - Units are to report to this Headquarters any German Ministry or portion thereof which has not been exploited.


