1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - See overlay, 35th Div was not in contact.
- b. Units in contact - 257th Inf Div and elements of 559th Inf Div and 6th SS Mountain Div on Div front. See overlay for units on adjacent fronts.
- c. Artillery - See overlay for identification of artillery units.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

- a. General summary - The enemy attitude in the Div sector and in the Corps sector has been defensive. Small patrols have been contacted during almost every 24 hour period, and sporadic light artillery has been falling upon our own forward elements. No armor has been reported in our sector, although SP fire is encountered.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Weather - Continued cloudiness with possible scattered snow during the period, with little change in temperature.
- b. Miscellaneous - Corps reports captured German password and reply for 25 January 1945 to be as follows: Cesetz - Blut.
- c. Password - CORSICA reply LAFAYETTE from 251200 to 261159 January 1945. A new method of challenge is now in effect for units of this command. The sentry (or person challenging) gives the password, and the person challenged gives the reply.
