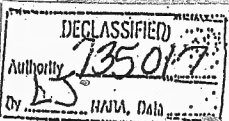

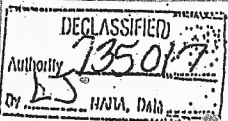

AHRWEILER	F5416	<p>Miscellaneous items of U S Army equipment were found including the following: Blanket, C rations, 1 pair Army overshoes, 1 pair of Army shoes. Persons arrested and turned over to MG.</p>
POLCH	L6989	<p>Two dummy potato-masher grenades and 30 German military maps of NORMANDY were confiscated.</p>
KOCHER	L5872	<p>The persons listed below with equipment were turned over to MG for prosecution:</p> <p>SHAFFER, Anna - 4 cans of US meat and 1 can US coffee</p> <p>RADEMACHER, Herman - 80 pounds of US flour</p> <p>LIPPHAUS, Anna - American cigarettes</p> <p>FUHLIS, Wilhelm - Nazi flag and sword</p>

TOWN	LOCATION	RESULTS OF SEARCH
BAD KREUZNACH	W0938	Numerous cameras were found which had not been previously reported by the owners. Bayonet and Hitler Jugend knife found in house of Elizabeth Ruokoroh, items confiscated and violator sent to MG. Two swords and American cigarettes were confiscated.
BIRKENFELD	L5916	Two small flags, one bayonet, one ceremonial knife, and one sword were found, along with some food excesses. MG has been notified and is investigating.
