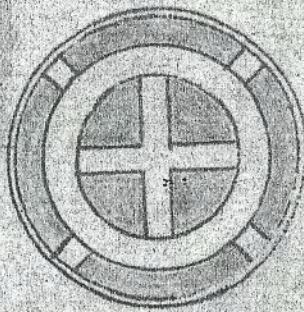

1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD:

- a. Enemy front line - See overlay. The Division was not in contact with the enemy during the period.
- b. Defensive organization - The divisions of Corps were not in contact with an organized defensive position at end of period. The enemy however was defending from positions in woods with small arms fire and direct SP fire. See overlay. Very few mines and road blocks were encountered during the period.
- c. Units in contact - The 60th Pz Gr Regt (116th Pz Div) was identified vicinity A3535 near the end of period; PWs state that this regiment arrived in the Corps sector this morning with out tanks. The 82nd Flak Bn was also identified during the period. See overlay. Units were reidentified as shown.
- d. Artillery - See overlay. No additional battery locations were reported during the period.
- e. Reserves and other forces capable of intervention - The 190th VG Div and the 156th Pz Gr Regt (116th Pz Div) are available as reserves in the Corps sector with maximum total of 4,000 men and 25 tanks or SP guns.
- f. Supply and Administrative Elements - See overlay. The Autobahn overpass over the railway and highway A365261 appears impassable by air reconnaissance.

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD:

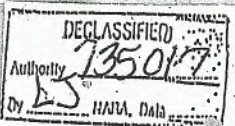
- a. General summary - Enemy attempted to delay the advance in the Corps sector with small arms fire and direct SP fire with some mortar fire being encountered by the forward elements.
- b. Operations of component elements:
 1. Armor - Three enemy tanks were encountered N of WEHOFEN A3226 during the period.
 2. Artillery - Direct SP artillery fire which reduced in intensity at end of period was encountered by the forward elements of Corps. See overlay.
 3. Infantry - Scattered small arms fire and mortar fire were received throughout the period as the enemy attempted to delay the advance.
 4. Miscellaneous - Tactical air reconnaissance reports approximately 30 vehicles, including some tanks and motor transports, moving S at 1135 vicinity A380305, and approximately 20 vehicles, with possibly some tanks, moving E at 1200 vicinity A400351.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a. Weather - Light intermittent rain tonight and tomorrow morning clearing later in the day with broken clouds - little change in temperature.
- b. Password - WHITE reply MULE from 261200 to 271200 March 1945.
