1. COUNTERINTELLIGENCE:

Identification of German GIS personnel: - Officers and men of the German Intelligence Service, when serving in the field, are attached to military units as low as Divisions (but not lower) and wear the uniform of the Wehrmacht. It is highly probable, therefore, that many G.I.S. members have already found their way into P.W. cages without being identified and that many more may follow. The following tests are suggested to identify them: (1) The reference in a prisoner's pay-book to the Ersatz-Pataillon 600, or the Lehrregiment Kuersfuerst, or the Nachrichten Regiment 506, as his base unit. (2) The description of a prisoner's unit in his papers by its Field Post Number...e.g. Dienststelle F.P. No... (In this case the F.P.N. should be checked against the list which will shortly be issued.) (3) The reference in a prisoner's papers to his being attached to the Ic (senior intelligence officer) of a Division, Corps, Army or Army Group. (See: SHAEF Thru VII Corps)

At LUDINGHAUSEN A 7952 arrested SACURNA, Theodore H J, member found with rubber blackjack and dagger. Sent to Camp Q as security threat. Arrested six officials on Kreis level at Coesfeld, the details on which are pending completion of a general survey in that area.
